SUBJECT: Establishment of a Port Maintenance & Servicing Unit

TO: Italian Port Commandant, Ministry of Marine
Attn: Colonel Sarti

1. Effective August 15, 1945, by order of the Commanding General of the Mediterranean Theatre of Operations, military authorities no longer will be able to perform the function of de-waterproofing and servicing of imported vehicles consigned for civilian purposes, and it will be necessary for some arrangement to be made immediately for port clearance and storage of such vehicles.

2. A servicing and maintenance unit also is needed for stavedoring gear and equipment used in the Italian Port Area.

3. It is suggested that a survey be made promptly of the possibilities for installing a port maintenance unit in the Italian Port Area. It is possible that if this area is not considered practicable for the purpose that our needs for such a unit may be used as a basis for asking additional berthing facilities be provided by military authorities.

4. We shall be glad to be of assistance to you through our Public Works & Utilities Representative Mr. Townsend or otherwise as possible.

SUBJECT: Servicing of Imported Civilian Vehicles

TO: Transportation Sub-Commission, P&W Div

1. We have been advised that a directive has been issued signed by the Commanding General, MTOUSA, reference FX 33975, dated 10 August, 1945, to the effect that commencing with August 15 Allied Commission will be responsible for de-waterproofing and servicing of all vehicles consigned for their account in ports of Leghorn and Naples.

2. Please advise us what arrangements can be made by Allied Commission Headquarters with respect to the clearance of such vehicles from the port. On one or two occasions Headquarters Maintenance Division has sent mechanics from Rome to perform this task and it will probably be necessary for this to be done in the future until servicing and maintenance units can be set up locally within the port area.
