SUBJECT: Dodge Ambulances - Disposal of unuseable vehicles.

TO : G - 5 Section, Allied Force Headquarters,
APO 512.
(Attn: Lt. Col. Crook-Johnson)

1. We can use the Dodge ambulances discussed in your T-4 of 14 March 1945 under the conditions stated if we are authorized to cannibalize to whatever extent is necessary to properly condition a maximum number.

2. Under your stipulations no spares or military maintenance facilities can be utilized and the vehicles themselves would be our only source of parts for reconditioning.

3. Contingent upon approval of this means of rehabilitation we are prepared to submit a request for these vehicles immediately on receipt of the details of holdings in Base RVPs.

SUBJECT: Dodge Ambulances - Disposal of Vehicles
no longer considered useable by AFSTO : Headquarters, Allied Commission, APO 394
(Attn: Transportation Sub-Commission)

1. It has now been agreed that Dodge Ambulances, Types T-211 and T-214 ex American Field Service held in Base Returned Vehicle Parks may be handed over to AC on the following conditions:

- (a) No spares will be available from American or British sources for the repair of these vehicles, and no demands will be placed on military supply organization.
- (b) Their re-habilitation must be carried out entirely in AC Maintenance shops and no demands for maintenance or repair will be made on military workshops.
- (c) AC must be responsible for evacuating these vehicles from RVPs to Maintenance shops.

2. Up to date details of holdings in Base RVPs are being obtained and will be forwarded as soon as available. Approximately 87 T-211 vehicles are thought to be available.

3. Will you please confirm that you require these vehicles and that you are prepared to accept them on the conditions laid down in para 1 above.
