SUBJECT : $\frac{1}{2}$ ton truck assignments

TO : Transportation Sub-Commission H.Q., A.C.
(Attn.: Roads Division).

1. Reference your AC/359/1/TN.5 dated 10 May 1945.
2. Two $\frac{1}{2}$ ton trucks have been assigned to the Transportation Sub-Commission and will be available as from Monday 14th May.
3. These two $\frac{1}{2}$ ton trucks will be located at 19, Viale Angelico and will operate out of this Headquarters' Motor Pool. They will be subject to the normal operating regulations and will be dispatched according to your requests through the Dispatch Office, telephone 577123 (Dispatch Sgt. Sgt. Green).
4. This Headquarters is supplying two Italian Civilian drivers; Italian Military personnel not being available.
5. This Headquarters wishes to draw attention to the fact that the shipment of 235 $\frac{1}{2}$ ton trucks was to supply control vehicles for the Q.M. Truck Bns. and Coys and the Transport Coys A.C. No control vehicles have been made available by A.F.H.Q.
6. The minimum requirements of the Q.M. Truck Bns. and Coys and Transport Coys are as follows:

Q.M. Truck Bn. and Coys
5 per Truck Bn. H.Q.
5 per Q.M. Truck Coy.

3 Bns. 24 Coys - 135

Transport Coys A.C.
6 per Coy. 10 Coys - 60

Transport Group H.Q. (Including two GRASC Transport Columns) 20
Total $\frac{1}{2}$ ton Trucks required 225.

7. Without this minimum number of control vehicles, the operations cannot be efficiently carried out.
