It has been brought to the attention of this Headquarters that 1 each Fiat 1500 was requisitioned on 5 December 1944, in the Province of Forli, by an officer of the 18th Air Depot Group, and that such action constituted an improper requisitioning of a vehicle by the requisitioning officer of one area in the area of another Command.

2. In connection with this specific instance, it is to be noted that the requisition took place prior to the publication by AFHQ and MTOUSA of directives pertinent to the requisitioning of vehicles and that, as of this date, no publications are outstanding which indicate the authority or co-ordination required when an officer of one command desires to requisition a vehicle in the area under another command.

3.
