SUBJECT: Allied Commission Supplies at UNRRA Motor pool - Naples
TO: Director of UNRRA Italian Mission

1. Several weeks ago, upon request of UNRRA, arrangements were made to use a number of Allied Commission trucks for emergency port clearance of UNRRA supplies and for transshipment to Rome inasmuch as the trucks were for delivery in Rome. Even of these trucks remain in UNRRA motor pool and cannot be moved because of missing parts, and one truck was stolen in front of the motor pool. No report was made to this office of the stolen truck and, when it was later recovered by the military police, it was stripped of tires and many parts.

2. Of four civilian trucks delivered to UNRRA motor pool, one vehicle is missing and twelve of sixteen tires were taken from the other three as well as most of the important parts.

3. Four road graders stored in the motor pool under arrangements effected by Public Works & Utilities subCommission also have been subjected to thievery, with batteries and parts missing.

4. Although reported to local supply and transportation officials of UNRRA, nothing has been done about correcting the situation in the motor pool nor in restoring the missing parts and we are, therefore, bringing the matter to your attention for appropriate action.

SUBJECT: Trucks, 1-1/2 Ton, on loan Allied Commission

1. Reference is made to Ed Indorsement, Headquarters, PBS, file AG 461.2 20082, of 9 August 1944, in which it was indicated that only 185 of 200 Chevrolet 1-1/2 ton 4 x 2 Trucks had been picked up in stock and re-issued to Allied Commission, and that spare parts for these trucks had not been received.

2. An investigation has been conducted by British Ordnance, and the whereabouts or disposition of the full 200 trucks ascertained. The list, by serial numbers, at Inclor re 1 covers 185 trucks. Subsequently, 11 additional trucks from the original shipment were turned over to Allied Commission by the Royal Navy. A list of these trucks is at Inclor 2.

3. Four (4) trucks of the original shipment have been accounted for as follows:

#5176285 and #4830821 salvaged.
#4830876 and #4830803 lost.

To cover the discrepancy of the above four (4) vehicles, (AE) AFHQ have authorized the release of 4 similar trucks from British stocks to PBS for re-issue to Allied Commission. The release order is attached at Inclor 3.

4. Sixty-three (63) cases of spare parts shipped on the SS FORT MOUSTENAY were delivered to Rome and received by Allied Commission (Capt Hays) in 2 lots, one of 52 cases and one of 1 case. 126 cases shipped on the SS EMPIRE WISE were shipped to Rome, via Naples, and Allied Commission (Capt Hays, Lt Ross, Capt Paterson) are satisfied that they were received.
