- 2) We shall then advise the Italian Government with a rider to recommend release to the Industry Sub Commission.
- 3) Furthermore the Industry Sub Commission state that upwards of 4000 tyre valves are lying at A.D.O.S. R.A.A.C., Stazione Tuscolana, Rome. It would appear more advantageous to declare these valves as a surplus than the 3000 originally designated from 557 R.A.D.

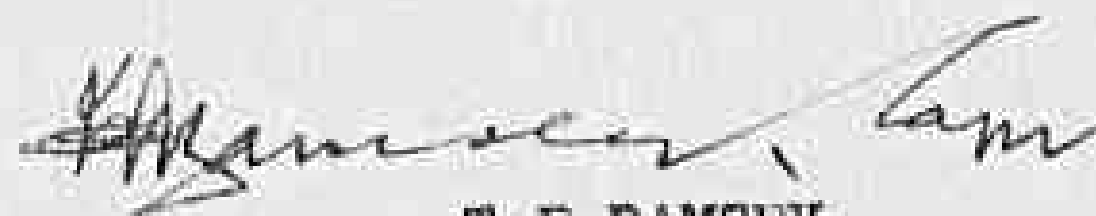

1. Phone conversation Lt. Col Carson/Lt. Col. Quartier refers.

2. It is suggested that the attached draft be dispatched as a MOC Airgram in order to secure authority for the transfer of Allied Military highway maintenance to the Italian Government.

3. Due to the termination of military responsibility for supply the requisition cannot be submitted by this headquarters. However, as soon as the MOC Airgram is dispatched we will comment favorably to CCAC by signal.

4. All trucks, except tank trucks, have been eliminated from the requirement because available trucks will be transferred to AC under the 80,000 ton lift recently approved.

5. Also attached is a list of British Army equipment on loan to Genio Civile contractors in No. 3 District.

6. Continued use of this equipment may be considered necessary to enable the Italian Government to assume responsibility for highway maintenance. If so, you are authorized to include appropriate items in the Airgram with the statement that they are actually in use on highway maintenance on a loan basis from the British Army, and are available for permanent transfer to the Italian Government.

7. It should be noted in connection with this list that it is expected that the Italian Government will assume responsibility for quarrying of stone for highway repair.

8. It is requested that the MOC Airgram be dispatched as quickly as possible.

3. Please advise the quantity of each item in para 2a and b that may be transferred to the Italian Government.

4. Allied Military forces have been maintaining main ^{and} subsidiary highways throughout Italy in order to keep the highways in condition to carry military and essential civilian traffic.

5. AFHQ have advised that it is imperative that military service units be relieved of this function as soon as practicable and have also stated that it is essential that highway maintenance be not permitted to fall below a level sufficient to support British and U.S. redeployment.

6. It is also necessary that withdrawal of military maintenance units will not interrupt the internal distribution of essential civilian supplies. Much of the automotive stock available for movement of civil supplies is in poor condition and failure to maintain the road network in reasonable condition will result in rapidly increasing rate of deterioration which will further jeopardize the movement of essential civilian supplies.

7. Ruined railways and lack of adequate deep water ports have placed great reliance on the highway system which itself has been badly worn and damaged.

8. With the termination of military responsibility for civilian supply it is desired that the Italian Government assume full responsibility for highway maintenance, and thus for internal civilian supply distribution which is dependent on the highway system. 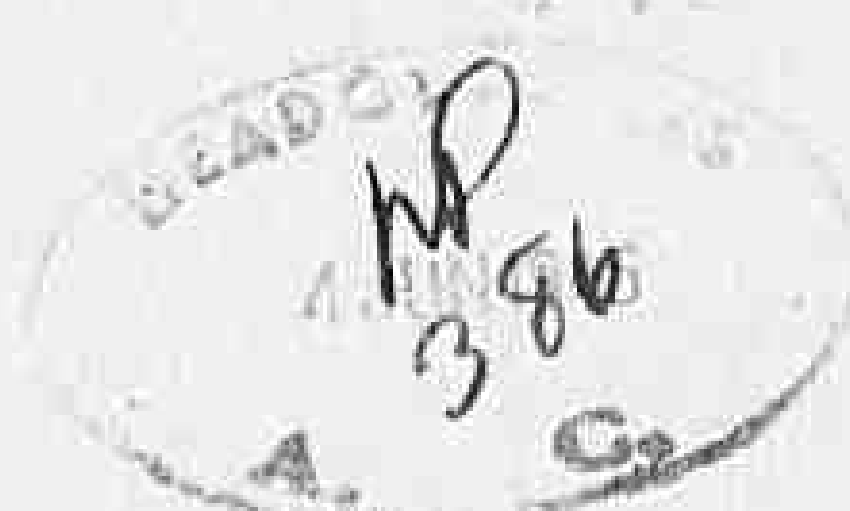

Our T-12 of 11 April 45 advised you of the release of some items ex British Army stocks. Our T-12 of 15 May 45, para 4 referred to those U.S. items originally under Service requisition MM-331 and then requested shipped under requisition no. KK-345. SUBJECT: New Tires Requisitioned on IAC Airgram 40 and Subsequent
Requisition Doubling the Original Demand

We are advised here by the International Division of CCAC that they have approved a total of 22,000 tires and 22,000 tubes for civilian use in Italy.

CCAC(S) states, however, that when approval of the two requisitions was given, a request was made to the Theatre to determine there the division of responsibility of source of supply, between U.K. and U.S.. The Theatre was furthermore requested to notify CCAC(S) as to the quantity of tires which could be supplied from Army stocks in the Mediterranean.

Neither of these requests for information have been replied to. The Theatre did call forward from the New York port of embarkation approximately 2,200 tires. The CCAC(S) agreed to release these, notwithstanding the irregularity of the demand, in light of the fact that AFHQ had not replied to questioning on source of supply and Theatre availability.

It is our understanding that somewhere over 4,000 tires have been made available to AC from Theatre stocks, but CCAC(S) is not aware of this.

It is suggested that you should take the necessary steps to see that the requested information is cabled to CCAC(S) as requested by them, and that every effort is made to arrange to call forward at the earliest possible time tires and tubes up to 20,000 each, discounting those that have been or can be made available in the Theatre.
