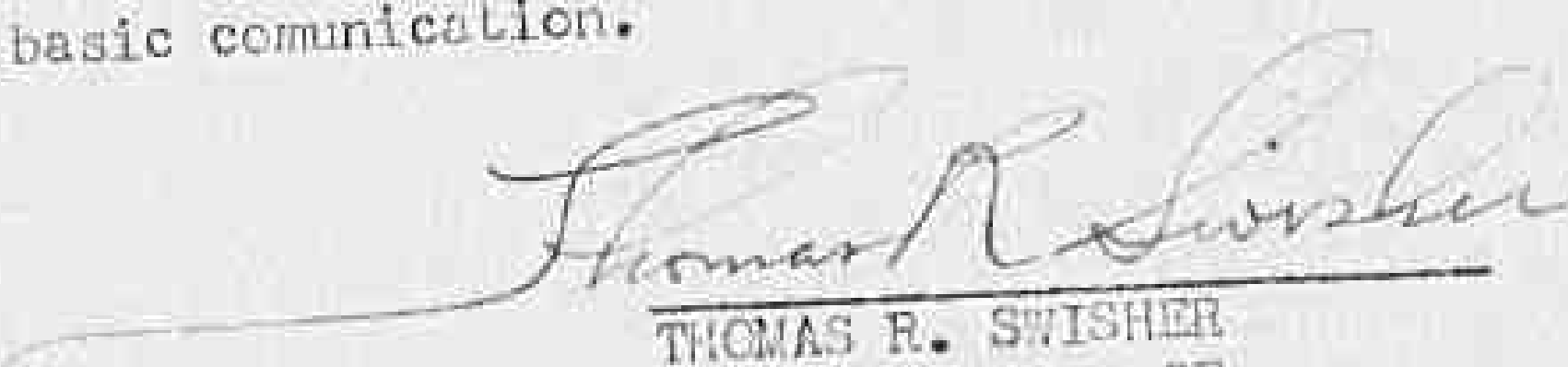

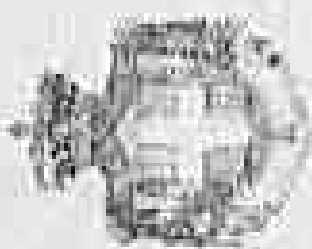

2. As these cranes are indispensable for the work at our Repair Shops, this organization is prepared to buy them for the Italian Government.

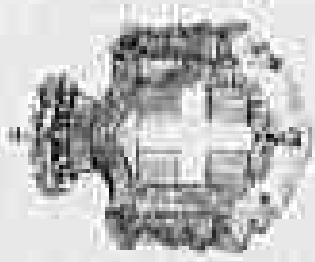

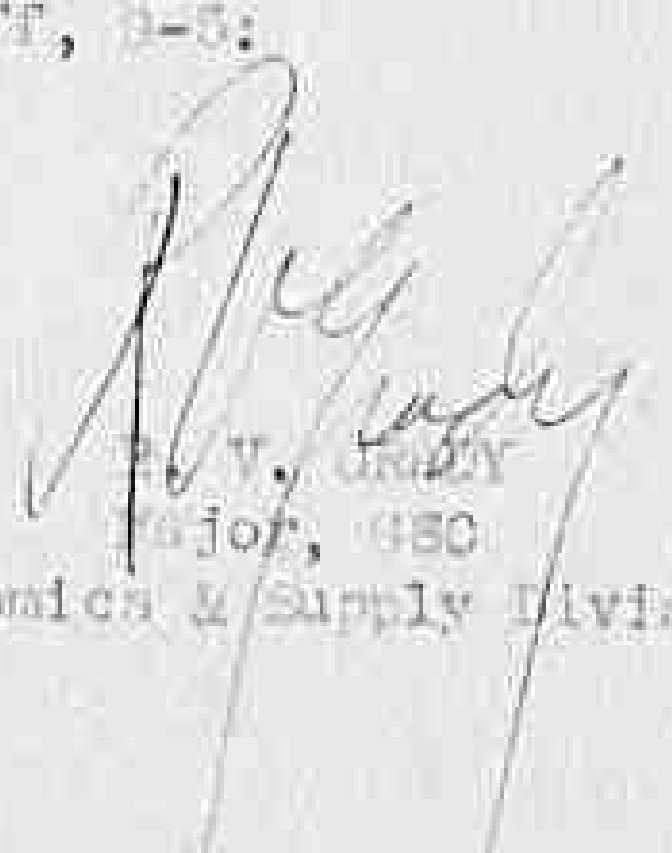
