ACTION BY

1. GENERAL ACMG (1) stated that he had called the meeting as doubt appeared to exist as to the responsibilities of GENIO CIVILE regarding repairs to the CI V vehs made available for road maintenance.
ACMG policy was that the Italian Authorities were responsible for making arrangements for veh repairs to the fullest degree possible with the civilian means available and that ST and RME facilities would only be called upon when the work required was beyond the powers of the civilian garage.

2. CIVILIAN It was reported that with the exception of CAVA the work which could be undertaken by civilian workshops was very limited due in some cases to lack of equipment and tools.
ACMG (1) did not consider that an application to AFHQ for release of equipment for this purpose would succeed.
No workshop had yet been provided in CALABRIA.
ACMG (1) stated that the civilian authorities should be pressed either to improve the present workshops or find alternate ones where these existed in the required centres.
In view of the delay which would inevitably occur if the matter was referred to RME it was agreed that AC LO would write to Civilian Authorities concerned calling for early provision of the best available facilities and would follow this up by visits to the centres concerned with OC Tpt Control Staff.

- AGHQ (1) requested ST rep to arrange cancellation of letter ref OE 3219/42 dated 25 May 45 addressed to GME.
4. SPARES OC Tpt Control Staff stated that if he was issued with authority to visit VDS and RSDs parts (incl tyres) for replacements could be utilised which would be of a high enough standard for use on these CL V vehs. At present he could draw new tyres but not used ones.
