1. Naples - Receipts and issues continue to be heavy.
2. Leghorn - Due to the Army's use of the port for its redeployment program, receipts of civil supplies continue to be practically nil.
3. Genoa - Because of the presence of mines in the harbor, ships are discharging cargo over the beaches. Receipts and issues are moderate.
4. Forli - Stocks have been completely withdrawn and warehouse closed.
5. Casena and Venice - No change.
6. Ancona - Inventory has reached a low level.

1. A serious shortage of warehouse space has developed in Naples, due to the fact that it has been ruled that no civil supplies will be handled in or out of Leghorn port at this time. Further, the failure of Genoa to open as scheduled has meant that all imports of civil supplies on the West Coast enter through Naples.

2. Exceedingly heavy withdrawals have been made from Cesena and Forli warehouses. Withdrawals exceed receipts.

3. A transport problem has arisen at Ancona because sufficient lift has not been provided to load from Ancona warehouses to Ancona railhead for onward shipment to Cesena and Forli.

4. No ^{civil} supplies for Italian use have as yet entered Venice by water.

5. Genoa warehouse team awaiting opening Genoa port.

1. Leghorn - Inventory at lowest level in months, but large quantity of flour is expected shortly.

2. Ancona - Operations were handed over to Federazione Italiana dei Consorzi Agrari on 31 March 45, without untoward difficulty. It is of some interest to note that the original two chiefs selected by the Federazione to head this operation were NOT approved by local British security check because of previous Fascist activities.

3. Naples - Shortage of wagons made meeting of week's rail program impossible.

4. Forli - Inventory slowly increasing.

5. Cesena - Premises occupied by a warehouse detachment but because of small quantity of tonnage allocated by rail from Ancona on the Forli line, it is not likely that actual Cesena operations will commence for some little time.

6. General - ALL warehouse operations have now passed into control of Federazione Italiana dei Consorzi Agrari.

 - a) Receipts have continued relatively heavy but road and rail lifts to Forlì, altho not as great as desired, have enabled considerably more movement than previously.
 - b) Warehouse repair work continues satisfactorily.

1. Leghorn:- Shipments considerably exceed receipts.

In addition arrangements have been made with Port Commandant to use in case of emergency certain space in the Tobacco Warehouse which it is estimated will hold 8,000 tons (covered storage) after repair. Situation in general is good.
3. Naples :- Federazione Italiana dei Consorzi Agrari took over operation of ALCOM Naples Warehouses 1 Mar 45. Transfer was without unusual difficulty.
