2. Our records were compiled from the Port dispatch tickets which show the issues at shipside to various P.B.S. Q.M. depots either direct by truck or to the port railhead for distribution from there. Since these records are also available to you, we would appreciate it very much if you would conduct a separate investigation and so ascertain whether our total claim for additional supplies shipped are as stated.
3. Since you agree in para 4 that you were over-shipped 837.5 m/tons sugar, could we please be issued as soon as practical 800 m/tons of sugar pending settlement of the above claim? We would appreciate it if these stores could be delivered as soon as possible to our Livorno Warehouse.
4. Since it is anticipated that you will have an investigation of the port dispatch tickets, could we defer all adjustments on flour until after your investigation?

1. Reference your W222/764/720 dated 16 February 1945 and the attached 53-1/44/Feed dated 23 January addressed to your office by the Director Food Sub-Commission.

2. The milk in question was transferred from the Consorzio Agrario Reggio to Whse 676 and by 676 to the Consorzio Agrario Naples. In actuality it went direct from CAP Reggio to CAP Naples. Southern Region AC did not come into the transaction since the Federazione dei Consorzi through the Consorzi Agrari, assumed accounting responsibility for feedstuffs as of 1 September 1944.

3. Since the milk was actually transferred from Consorzio Agrario Reggio to the Consorzio Agrario Naples and was not taken into 676, this office is of the opinion that any claim arising from spoiled milk included in the shipment should be made by the Consorzio Agrario direct to the Federazione dei Consorzi.

1. Enclosed is copy of a letter received from Officer in charge of Warehouse 676, Naples, summarizing his experiences in loading the S/S SAMOTA. The Samota was scheduled to load from 2500 to 3500 tons AC supplies but was taken away on 18 February after loading 538 tons. The Samota is to be replaced by the S/S FARR, ETA 26 February, which will load the balance.

2. You will note that 538 tons was loaded in about 3 days, or about 180 tons per 24 hour day. On that basis it would have taken about two weeks to have loaded 2500 tons.

3. Presumably the same problems will be faced by the warehouse in loading the S/S FARR.

1. The task was to load 2,500 tons, including 1000 tons lard in steel drum (15 - one lorry load) working 24 hours per day.

2. A warning memo was sent from this office to all concerned and "a request" submitted to zone Tn. for fifteen lorries on 13 Feb. 1945.

3. Fifteen was purposely a very modest figure for the task but I has no firm date on which to commence loading nor the number of hatches to be worked. The lard was in fact stacked on the wharf.

4. Orders to commence were received thro the P.L.C. about 1130 hours on 15 Feb. these were passed at once to Zone Tn. by telephone Sgt. SIMPSON (Zone Tn) was in charge of the job and he and Sgt. MILLER (676) kept in constant touch. When Sgt. Simpson has completed his investigation it may be established that lorries detailed for the work did not actually report or were late in reporting.

5. On 15 Feb only four loads were moved between 1400 and 1910 hours. From then on work proceeded slowly with gaps of hours with no lorries working. Sgt. Simpson was kept informed periodically of the position. During one or two periods fifteen lorries were employed.

6. Between 1400 hours 15 Feb. and the forenoon 18 Feb. 2,543 barrels, approx 538 M/tons gross, were moved. Tn. Officers are in a position to say whether this is a good performance.

7. Records show one barrel disappeared and one was emptied of its contents between 696 and Berth 10 and three drivers failed to return with Port receipts. Guards accompanied all lorries. Specific reports of these irregularities have been made.

8. No lorries whatsoever reported for work on the afternoon of Sub, 18 Feb. It is assumed the drivers regarded this as a holiday.

9. The tn. O.S.R. has been out of Naples for most of the period of this operation.

SUBJECT: Shortages on AC Cargoes of Food

FROM : Food Sub-Commission

TO : Transportation Sub-Commission

1. Recent reports showed the following shortages on AC cargoes of food arriving in Naples.

(a) Approximately 400 tons of flour are short from flour cargoes on the ships *MENENDEZ* and *COSTIN*.

(b) 1,096 tons of sugar short in cargo arriving on the *GRANT WOOD*.

2. Enquiries have been made of your Port Warehousing and Forwarding Division and it appears that in both cases the shortages were due to over-issues to PBS. They also report, however, that they have been unable to clear the matter with PBS, and, therefore, we are still lacking these supplies.

3. The loss of sugar, apart from the large amount involved, is particularly important to us, as it represents 40% of the total sugar imports for one month into Italy. It is requested that you make further efforts to clear the matter with PBS in order to recover these shortages, and that if satisfaction cannot be obtained, the matter be referred to AFHQ with a request for an enquiry.

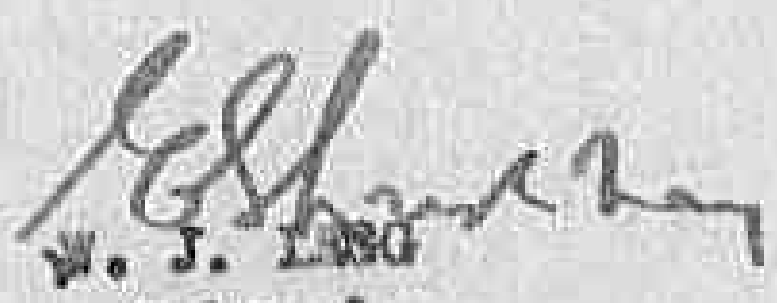
