

1. On November 28, 1944 the roof and walls collapsed at Alcom Warehouse 12L54 which was stored with flour at that date. Due to this accident 183 bags of flour totalling 12,244 Kgs of flour were destroyed. Rubble and cement became mixed with the flour causing this loss.

2. A loss of 111 sacks of flour totalling 7,427 Kgs was incurred at Alcom warehouse 12L52. This warehouse was receiving broken sacks of flour from the S.S. Richelieu and until an inventory and salvage could be completed these sacks were accounted for as being full. Following an inventory and salvage the following facts were disclosed:




