1. Apparently CAL 1517 not understood by you. Combined coal committee was requested to make an allocation for VENEZIA GIULIA and UDINE on basis combined military responsibility. Combined coal committee stated that no additional coal could be allocated for any areas in ITALY and that supply for VENEZIA GIULIA and UDINE would have to come out of allocations already MDE for ITALY (see para 3 coal 1517). Therefore, in CAL 1517 para 1 you were requested to consult Allied Commission and other inter agencies and agree a readjustment of these allocations so as to provide allocation for VENEZIA GIULIA and UDINE. This does not mean participation by UNRRA in these areas. Once the allocations are readjusted to provide for these areas, responsibility for supply will 0 in the combined military.
  2. Para 2 CAL 1517 stated that after readjustment of existing allocations, shipment of 2 months supply would be authorized. Since you have not determined these as yet, your call forward as stated in para 3 LAC 1360 cannot be recognized billings.
