265. TRANSFERRING OF MILITARY RESPONSIBILITY - ALBANIA (See para 261).

It is considered improbable that UNRRA will be able to take over responsibility for AUSTRIA on 1 Jul as negotiations for the completion of UNRRA/ALBANIA agreement are presently in abeyance. Confirmation has however been received from UNRRA ALBANIA that necessary action will be taken by UNRRA to set up shipping programmes for Aug arrivals.

It has been recommended that:-

- (a) The balance of the Balkan Stockpile in MIDEAST for ALBANIA be handed over to UNRRA as at 30 Jun.
- (b) Responsibility for relief to ALBANIA be assumed by UNRRA now later than 1 Aug with an additional proviso that Supply of requirements for ALBANIAN relief for arrival during Aug and subsequent months be responsibility of UNRRA as already arranged.

It is considered improbable that UNRRA will be able to take over responsibility for AUSTRIA on 1 Jul as negotiations for the completion of UNRRA/ALBANIA agreement are presently in abeyance. Confirmation has however been received from UNRRA ALBANIA that necessary action will be taken by UNRRA to set up shipping programmes for Aug arrivals.

It has been recommended that:-

(a) The balance of the Balkan Stockpile in MIDEAST for ALBANIA be handed over to UNRRA as at 30 Jun.

(b) Responsibility for relief to ALBANIA be assumed by UNRRA not later than 1 Aug with an additional proviso that Supply of requirements for ALBANIAN relief for arrival during Aug and subsequent months be responsibility of UNRRA as already arranged.

258. AUG SUBSISTENCE REQUIREMENTS - AUSTRIA.

Given below are allocations against Aug subsistence requirements for AUSTRIA (all in metric tons):-

These allocations do not constitute approval of any requirement and allocations for other items will be given when supply responsibility is known.

259. FLOUR, AUSTRIA.

A proposal has been submitted to SHARP that the requirement of 3750 nett long tons of flour per fortnight for the U.S./French zones (excluding GAIU VIENNA) be provided and lifted by SHARP - Should provisioning action not be possible, the diversion of vessels now afloat has been proposed. Alternatively arrangements could be made for the transfer to SHARP of a proportion of CCS credit of 120,000 tons allocated to AFHQ for AUSTRIA but not yet called forward.

260. PYRIDES

Requirements for Pyrites have been given as

FRANCE	100,000 tons
BELGIUM	Nil.
SWITZERLAND	60,000 tons (spread over 1 year)

No demand has yet been received from NETHERLANDS.

Total availability is 100,000 tons of which it is proposed to allocate 50,000 tons to AFHQ pending a decision regarding Swiss requirements.

261. TERMINATION OF MILITARY RESPONSIBILITY - ALBANIA.

WASHINGTON has stated that following discussions with UNRRA, 1 Jul is believed to be a convenient date for the termination of military responsibility for ALBANIA, with the exception of EOL. UNRRA will take over the remainder of the Balkan stockpile received for ALBANIA which has not been shipped or loaded

Alternatively arrangements could be made for the transfer to SHAREP of a proportion of CCS credit of 120,000 tons allocated to AFHQ for AUSTRIA, but not yet called forward.

260. PYRITES

No demand has yet been received from NETHERLANDS.
Total availability is 100,000 tons of which it is proposed to allocate 50,000 tons to FRANCE pending a decision regarding Swiss requirements.

261. TERMINATION OF MILITARY RESPONSIBILITY - ALBANIA.

WASHINGTON has stated that following discussions with UNRRA, 1 Jul is believed to be a convenient date for the termination of military responsibility for ALBANIA, with the exception of POL. UNRRA will take over the remainder of the Balkan stockpile received for ALBANIA which has not been shipped or loaded for shipment up to 30 Jun.

AFHQ comments have been requested.
