Ref. Signal 905, 5/9/45.

1. Rail cars No. 261150, 226080, 1030051 were received at ALCOM Depot No. 12, Venice, with 3 other rail cars. All 6 cars contained soap.
2. As this depot had not been advised of the arrival nor of the disposition of these 6 rail cars of soap, they were believed to be for distribution in Venezia Region, and the Regional Supply Officer was notified. The soap was released by Region and shipped according to instructions to the Medical Supply Depot, Padua.
3. Upon receipt of the above signal way bills of the 3 Rail cars were rechecked and they actually show as final destination Trieste.
4. Though this office acknowledges that this should have been noticed and acted upon at once, it requests that signals be sent in future so that proper action can be taken and similar mistakes be avoided.

- 1 A new warehouse has been opened at Trieste and will be run by the A.M.G. of Venezia Giulia. During Phase I, this organisation is known as "A.M.G. 13th Corps".
- 2 This Warehouse will not work on the same principle as other A.C./Federazione Warehouses elsewhere in liberated Italy, in as much as the supplies will be the property of A.M.G. and will not be owned by the Federazione. This means that all supplies transferred from AC/Federazione or local Consorzi Warehouses to the Trieste Warehouse, will be taken on charge by A.M.G. ex Federazione Warehouse platform and a Receiving Report given by A.M.G. to Federazione. In view of the fact that A.M.G. 13th Corps will not have representatives at issuing Warehouses to sign for the supplies on the spot, the AC/AMG officer i/c the Issuing Warehouse will sign the Receiving Report on behalf of A.M.G. 13th Corps.
- 3 One copy should be forwarded by the Issuing Warehouse to the Inter-Regional Office of the Federazione. (See para 3 (b) below). SUBJ: Report on Trip to Trieste,
Friday 11 May 1945.

TO: R. B. Macgillivray,
Chief, Ports & Warehouse Division

1. Contacts were made with the following:

Lt. Col. Sykes, Senior Supply Officer, 5th Army AGO;
Lt. Col. Curtis, Port Commandant, Trieste;
Major Smith, Asst. Port Commandant, Trieste;
Lt. Col. Slater, A.G. 15 Area;
Lt. Col. Scholtz, Provincial Commissioner, Venezia Giulia.

2. Lt. Col. Curtis and Lt. Col. Slater, at their own level reached an agreement in writing with the Yugoslav Headquarters in Trieste, whereby the British will immediately use one pier and certain adjacent beach area which can accommodate landing craft type ships. The British will use local Italian port labor, inasmuch as, it was agreed to permit British Military Port Operating Companies into the harbor area. No military stores or A. G. civil stores will be warehoused in Trieste at this time.

3. AGO is not in operation in Trieste, although personnel is on hand.

4. In the event that the S/S HENKESON, now under load at Ancona with various military supplies and 500 tons AC food stuffs should discharge at Trieste, arrangements were made with Lt. Col. Curtis, Lt. Col. Scholtz and Lt. Col. Snodgrass to dispose of these supplies.

5. Col. Slater advised that a very large warehouse had been set aside for AG use, in the event that the original plan for Trieste to be used as a military port becomes operative. This warehouse was inspected. It is perhaps 1/4 of a mile from the port; will easily accommodate any AC supplies likely to be shipped into Trieste; is in excellent state of repair, is well rail served, and has ingress and egress for trucks, as well as large storing area. It is presently occupied partially by officers of I.S.S. as well as by Yugoslav troops.
