1. With further reference to your letter dated 21 January 1946, wish to inform that your instructions for disposal and/or transfer of unaccounted goods in Genoa Warehouse have been complied with.
- a) 4 cases containing paring knives. Quartermaster Depot, Class II and IV, Leghorn, have been informed and arrangements for the removal of these goods have been made.
- b) 4 Tarpaulins. They have been turned over to Federazione Consorzio Agrario and receipt is in file.
- c) 5 cases containing 18 cartons spare parts. In accordance with Release Order n. 425 dated 9/11/46, cases have been delivered to the Italian Ministry of Transport. Receipted copy of Release Order is with this office and herewith is copy of same as requested by you.

1. In reference to your letter dated 11/1/46, subject as above, instructions for disposal and or transfer of unaccounted for goods in Genoa Warehouse are given as below.

4 cases containing paring knives. It is evident from your report that these goods are US Army property, therefore, they should be turned over to class II and IV Quartermaster Depot. If such Depot does not exist in Genoa, immediate contact should be made with Quartermaster PBS Leghorn, advising them of the existence of these goods and asking for their removal.

4 Tarpaulins. They should be turned over to Federazione Consorzio Agrario to cover perishable goods.

2 cases of evaporated milk. It seems rather superfluous to ask for or to have to issue instructions for such item. According to the markings they should be turned over either to Quartermaster or Federazione Consorzio Agrario.

5 cases containing 18 cartons spare parts, Release Order # 425 dated 9/1/46 has been issued by Transportation Sub-Commission Roads Division to Italian Ministry of Transport.

Dunnage. Should be held for disposal by W.S.A. who has to be kept informed of the quantity.

53 bags of rice. SEPRAL has been requested to remove this rice immediately from the Warehouse as per inclosed copy of letter to SEPRAL.
