Great importance is attached to the prompt discharge of cargo and the release of vessels in any POMBING operation, reference PBS 1179, 27 January.

This headquarters will entertain requisitions for cargo discharging gear from ALCOM, however, the use of coal macs in preference to self operating buckets, in view of the importance of quick ship discharge, is not looked on with favor, particularly if there are self operating buckets or clam shells available from either US or BRITISH sources.

Desired also is a close estimate on the date the railway line will be in operation from the discharge quay to the main line, together with the loading track capacity for railway wagons and finally the estimated tons of coal it has been agreed should be discharged per day and whether this is an around the clock operation and whether in even of shortage of rail wagons it is planned to back pile coal

I am making the following reductions in British naval establishments in Italy with effect from the dates shown:

(A) With the exception of the Commander in Chief, Mediterranean Station's Command Post, all British naval establishments in the Naples Area will be closed down on 15th Jan. 1946.

(B) All British naval establishments at Taranto will be closed down by 31st Jan. 1946.

(C) All British naval establishments at Leghorn will be closed down by 15th Feb. 1946.

(D) The British Naval Control Service Officers and staffs will be withdrawn from Bari, Ancona and Genoa on 31st Dec. 1945.

2. At each port, however, it may be necessary to retain certain personnel for the purpose of winding up R.N. commitments beyond the target dates shown above.

3. I shall be glad if you will inform the local Italian naval authorities concerned of my intentions.

2. However strike settled October 17th and miners returned to work October 22nd. Solid fuels administration stated it cannot expect any pickup in shipments until November 1st since will take approx 2 weeks after miner return to work to realize any appreciable increase in production. They have made assurances, however, that coal shipments will be resumed as soon as possible and continued at maximum rate possible. Your second para MOC 335 answered COM cable 248.
