



SUBJECT: Railway weighbridge at Civitavecchia Port.

We refer to our letters of 14 June and 26 Sept. 1945, to which no reply has been received.

There are arriving in this port steamers with bulk grain which has to be weighed prior to despatch.

The lack of a railway weighbridge, asked for since 14 June 1945 has caused, and causes, serious inconveniences among which I would mention:

a) slowness in discharge due to weighing at ship's side, which has reduced by 50% the daily discharge output of steamers, causing heavy expenses to the Italian Govt. owing to the long stay of ships in port;

b) the double handling of goods with heavy increase in cost of discharging operations;

c) a greater waste of grain, in consequence of the multiple handling of the goods.

The seriousness of the situation requires prompt intervention on the part of the responsible Authorities, in order that the weighbridge, which was asked for four months ago, be set up.

We would point out that the expenses which the State incurs under present conditions of discharge of grain in bulk are considerably higher than the cost of a weighbridge which latter item would, in a short space of time, be fully covered.

1. Attached is a list of correspondence, the subject matter of which appears to fall within the procedure for obtaining U.S. Army surplus theatre items. This procedure was discussed by Colonel Goultaine/Captain Lettropre and Mr. Dickens/Captain Lettropre.
2. Briefly, this procedure calls for securing by the Italian Commission of Supply a list of the Italian Government to purchase the required supplies through DIME, and cancellation of the requirements to DIME. DIME endeavours to make the supplies available to the Italian Government, and will instruct the requirement to DIME if the Italian Government does not allow such action to take place.
3. Attached letter # 41203/35000 to you dated 15 Oct., copy to Transportation and Commission, and the letter copy of the enclosure sets forth the action taken by this Headquarters to release equipment for the civilian operated section of the Naples port. It should complete arrangements directly with DIME in order to prevent permanently to secure the equipment for the Italian Government.
4. No other action is being taken by the Italian Government section for the supply of items detailed in the attached list of references.
5. Requests for material from British War Office may be submitted to Chief Fiscal Office, Ministry of Supply. If the circumstances warrant it, your requirements may be submitted to GHQ USAF, under the procedure outlined in our letter # 21 of 26 October to Economic Section.

1. Attached is a list of correspondence, the subject matter of which appears to fall within the procedure for obtaining Army surplus supplies while this procedure was discussed by General Gauthier/Baptiste in letter/reply to Stoenen/Captain LaTropé.

- a. Briefly, this procedure consists screening by HQ, an indication of willingness to use part of the Italian Government to purchase the required supplies through AMIC, and submission of the requirements to HQ. Once HQ has been so informed, the supplies required to fill the order will be secured via the usual supplies channels.
- b. Attached letter AC 410-1/2000, to the Italian Ambassador copy to Transportation Sub Commission, and G-2 Major G-2 of 25 October 2000 forth the action taken by the Headquarters to release equipment for the original operation section of the Supply Port. This should complete arrangements directly with AMIC in order permanently to secure the equivalent for the Italian Government.
- c. No other action is being taken by HQ at this or later section for the supply of items detailed in the attached list of references.
- d. Requests for material from British forces may be submitted to Office of Disposal Office, Ministry of Defense. If the circumstances warrant it, your requirements for C-2 to be submitted to DHC CDF, under the procedure outlined in our letter P-21 of 25 October to economic section.

3. No doubt in advising us of actual dispatch and correct quantities, you will send copy of communication to the ALCOM Port Liaison Officer, Civitavecchia.
4. Reference our letter AG/ES/43/Tn6 of 23 August, it is of the utmost importance that a very special effort be made by you to procure the 8k,000 ft. of barbed wire and necessary number of nails for prompt dispatch to ALCOM Port Liaison Officer, Civitavecchia, for Capitano di Porto, Civitavecchia.
5. This material, as already informed you, is required to complete the port security measures, and as it is feared there may be trouble with the number of refugees using the port of Civitavecchia, you will realize the absolute urgency for this material to be handed to the Captain of the Port for the work of erection to be proceeded with.
