Subject : Surplus Materials.

On Monday July 9, 1945 in Room 35 - 7th Floor Annex, a meeting was held to discuss the availability of surplus materials for ports and warehouses. The following people were present:

Mr. Charles Ryan - Chairman
Major Schultz - British Increments
Mr. A. C. Allen - Ports & Warehouse Division
Mr. James B. Hurley - Ports & Warehouse Division.

Mr. Ryan opened the meeting by introducing Major Schultz from British Increments (Movements).

Major Schultz stated that in the very near future certain port materials of all types would be made available for purchase to the Allied Commission for the Italian Government.

Mr. Ryan stated that a Program had been completed recently by the Transportation Sub-Commission covering period October, November and December 1945. This Program is being sent to Washington in a very short time to be screened by the Combined Chiefs of Staff.

It was suggested to Major Schultz that if British Increments could make a list of their availabilities known to the Allied Commission, it might expedite the sale of material to the Italian Government. Major Schultz declared that he would discuss this matter further with his superiors and saw no reason why the list could not be made available.

Mr. Ryan explained that at the present time because of our close liaison with the Office of the Ministry of Marine, Direzione Generale Della Marina Mercantile, we could make all arrangements for the purchase of small port gear within a very short time.

SUBJECT : Transfer of Surplus Equipment

TO : War Shipping Administration, Mediterranean

1. It has been and remains the policy of the Allied Commission to insure as far as is possible that any American or British surplus equipment in the Italian Theatre is disposed of to the Italian Government through its appropriate Ministry, and not to any private firm or individual; disposal to such firms or individuals being carried out by the Italian Ministry in question.

2. It is presumed that the above is also the policy of the WSA. On the other hand, in two cases recently, there seems a little doubt as to whether this principle is being rigidly applied.

3. It is understood that at the moment you are negotiating for the purchase from MWT of seven barges now at Civitavecchia with the apparent intention of handing them over to the Italian agents of an American Shipping Line, without allocation by the Ministry of Marine.

4. Also, it is understood, you are proposing to take over from MTOUSA certain stevedoring equipment, shortly to be declared surplus at Naples, and to hand this over to certain specific American shipping agents, rather than to the Italian Port Authorities, as has heretofore been the practice.

5. Allied Commission is extremely interested in such transactions, as it is felt there should be no suggestion, when such surplus equipment is being disposed of in this theatre, that any private firm or individual is being given any semblance of preferential treatment. It is requested, therefore, that you will let this Headquarters know what is your general policy in this connection, with particular reference to the two examples quoted above.

1. Army stores which have been released to the Ministry of Supply for disposal because "commercial" cargo. Existing instructions for the backloading of army cargo to the U.K. are not affected.

2. The procedure for the shipment of Ministry of Supply Cargo is as follows:-

(a) The Ministry of Supply advises the Istituto Nazionale per il Commercio Estero (I.C.E.) Via Torino 107, ROME, of any cargo available for shipment; this information is collected by I.C.E. and forwarded to Messrs di Luggo Wood & Co., 5 Via Salvatore Tusce, NAPLES, who have been appointed by the U.K. Conference Lines (Peninsular and Mediterranean Committee) to act as their general agents for ITALY and SICILY. Messrs di Luggo Wood then inform I.C.E. of the name of the vessel and estimated date of readiness.

(b) Messrs. di Luggo Wood & Co., are also responsible for advising the Committee of Agents at each port the particulars of vessels nominated to load from their area, and I.C.E. advises the Ministry of Supply when and to which port they should call forward their cargo.

(c) The Ministry of Supply is proposing to its I.C.E. in LONDON the possibility of establishing a transport organisation in ITALY under the jurisdiction of the Chief Disposal Officer for the purpose of delivering cargo to the ships side. They may, however, wish to appoint a forwarding agent to effect this. It is the Ministry of War Transport's responsibility, so long as vessels are under their control, to ensure that ships' agents appointed by the U.K. Conference Lines are efficient in their duties. Should the Ministry of Supply desire to use the Ships' Agents to attend to the necessary formalities in calling forward of their cargo, and arranging shipment and documentation at the port, these Ships' Agents will no doubt be in a position to assist them in their capacity as Forwarding Agents.

(d) The Ships' Agents will sign an M.O.T. Mediterranean form of Bill of Lading which will not be a receipt to the Ministry of Supply, and, as a document of title, should be forwarded by the Ministry of Supply to the consignee in order that he may obtain delivery of the cargo.

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(d) The Ships' Agents will sign an M.O.T. Mediterranean form of Bill of Lading which will act as a receipt to the Ministry of Supply, and, as a document of title, should be forwarded by the Ministry of Supply to the consignee in order that he may obtain delivery of the goods. Freight will be payable on this commercial cargo, and for the present, for vessels under the control of the Ministry of War Transport, the Bill of Lading will be caused "Freight Payable Forward," or "Freight Payable in LONDON" by agreement Ministry of Supply and Ministry of War Transport. Freight earned on British controlled vessels is not at present acceptable in lire.

3. The Ministry of War Transport's representatives have been withdrawn from the ports, and at the major ports MWT Correspondents appointed. The latter will be in a position to assist and advise should any difficulties arise during the interim period of the Ministry's handing over to commercial concerns.

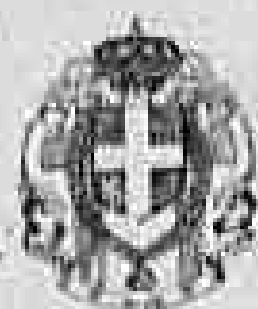
