SUBJECT : Schooner "MARE NOSTRUM" - Shortage Report

TO : Capt. Kelly, ALCON Depot Ancona

1. Investigation of the shortage of 24 Bags of sugar indicates that the schooner was unloaded directly on the quay, where cargo remained, unprotected, for some time.

2. It is hoped that this information will be used to prevent recurrences of similar incidents.

1. Inclosed is Ship's Unloading Report covering A/M schooner, loaded at Catania, and discharged at Ancona from the 8th to 12th Dec 44.
2. Investigation indicates that all "convoy notes" covering movement from the docks to the ALCOM Depots were accounted for. "Convoy Notes" are those tickets made by the Port Bn. covering truck shipment from ship side to depot.
3. Since the schooner carried a copy of the manifest, it seems only explanation of 24 bag shortage could come from schooner Captain.
4. Request necessary investigation.
