1. It is believed ALL empty sacks on the A/M consignment were received and accounted for at Naples. The packing or baling of these sacks was un-uniform, and there were various types and sizes of sacks completely mixed together.

2. It was therefore considered not unlikely that the original manifest figure of 105,000 might be in error, and that a further checks at your end might throw light on the apparent shortage of 13,080 sacks.




