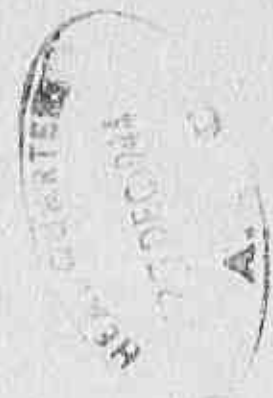

1. Understand that there are 64 tons of mining and blasting equipment on hand at FIDU V-10 consigned to ALLIED ORGANIZATION. 71 tons for SLOPE and 6 tons SANDHILL discharged from NEAVELEY was 6 1/2 tons for PALMRO and 2 tons SANDHILL discharged from SANDHILL was 6 1/2 tons available from SANDHILL was 60.

2. If this is confirmed arrange ship on SANDHILL all Seropian and on 13 all SEROPAN traffic both vessels will sail ADRIAN TO SEROPAN to load phosphate.
