



SUBJECT : Discharge of S.S. "CHARLES O." at Naples
and Torre Annunziata.TO : U.S. War Shipping Administration, Rome
(Attn. Mr. Regan).

1. References your letter dated July 30th and the attachment from W.S.A. Caserta of July 26th 1945.

2. A complete report has been received on this matter from the AC Port Liaison Officer at Naples and a copy is attached for your information.

3. Replying to para 3 of the letter from W.S.A. Caserta :-

(a) Consorzio Agrario do not route vessels owned by the War Shipping Administration or any other shipping authorities.

(b) Consorzio Agrario do not decide the quantity to be discharged from any particular vessel, but act only on instructions from this Headquarters through the Port Liaison Officer.

(c) Neither Allied Commission nor the Consorzio Agrario have any desire whatsoever to interfere in the control of W.S.A. shipping, but Allied Commission will continue to maintain the right to state the port where cargo is required and where delivery can be accepted.

4. It has been a long standing practice in agreement with W.S.A. Caserta, that vessels carrying civilian cargo move freely between Naples and the satellite port ³⁵⁹⁴ of Castellamare and Torre Annunziata to effect a speedy discharge providing it is done in agreement between the Port Authorities, the Shipping Authorities and AC Port Liaison Officer without

reference to either this headquarters or Caserta.

5. Had this practice been fully appreciated by the U.S.A. Port Representative, the "CHARLES C. GLOVER" would not have lost any working time, the vessel could have moved over night from Naples to Torre Annunziata, and it is probable that there would not have been any loss of the Nitrate cargo by fire caused by internal combustion in the backpile on the quay.

6. It is suggested that, in view of the difficulties which arose in Naples over the movement of this vessel, if U.S.A. Caserta continue to agree with the practice of moving ships as mentioned in para 4, they should notify their representative at Naples, so that there is full understanding locally of the methods to be followed in the future.
