1. Reference our letter V-2 of 13 August to A.C. and our signal PX-33726 of 9 August to TROOPERS.

2. The following information has been received at this Headquarters concerning shipment of Veterinary Supplies from UK.

a. Veterinary Laboratory Units. MGS-221-MED item 164. Two units were assigned UK supply responsibility by CAL 1175. Six cases were shipped on FORT LA HAVRE Index No. 215/57 consigned COMD NAPLES. Balance of 2 cases to complete 2 units to be shipped in August.

b. Basic Veterinary Units. MGS-221-MED item 162. 130 units assigned UK responsibility by CAL 1175 shipped in part as follows:

(1) EMPIRE STEAMHOLD - Index No. KK 221/93. 260 cases 8 1/2 tons consigned COMD, NAPLES.

(11) EMPIRE BARRIE - Index No. KK 222/138 (shut out from KK 221/92). 879 cases 42 tons 3 cwt, consigned COMD NAPLES.

c. Basic Veterinary Units. MGS-221-MED item 162. 70 units assigned U.S. supply responsibility by CAL 1175. Firevan unavailable in U.S. and to complete the units 420 boxes of Firevan in 2 cases weighing 1 cwt. 20 lbs were shipped on KK 222 - EMPIRE BARRIE from UK consigned COMD NAPLES, via MFO. (MFO Port No. 1532).

d. Firevan. MGS-265-MED. 8712 doses in 6 cases weighing 3 cwt. 58 lbs were shipped on KK 219 - FORT BARRIE, consigned COMD NAPLES, via MFO (Port No. 1276).

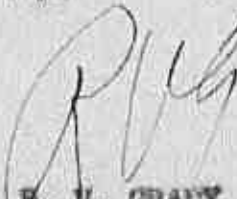
3. If these supplies are not available to AC through COMD, a search should be made at the Ports where the ships were discharged.

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4. For your information an additional 1650 boxes of Firevan in 6 cases, weight 4 cwt 7 1/2 lbs, were shipped on LL 188 PORT TIGONEROKIA consigned COMB, BARI, via HFO. (HFO Port No. 213). This Firevan, however, applies against a Balkan requisition and should be delivered to UNTER, BRINDISI.
