1. Out-Turn Report on the above named ship indicates shortage of 36 ploughs.
2. Explanation on the report from the Federazione states that these goods were discharged partially onto barges and that no access to the barges is available.
3. There is no reason why access to the barges cannot be had. In paragraph 3 of AFM letter G-4 (Mov. & Tr) 5/86/531, 21 February 45, subject: "Admission of Italian Officials to Military Ports," it states in part:
"The agent at the first port of arrival in ITALY will take delivery of the copy Manifest and will be responsible for controlling the checking from the end of ship's tackle, of all items of civil supplies listed on Manifest. In the event of a ship discharging at more than one berth or port, arrangements will be made by Allied Commission for their agents at the second or more ports of discharge to continue the check until its supplies are completely discharged."
4. Consequently, it is firmly established that the Italian ⁵³ have the right to board the ship and/or the barges, if the ship is not discharging at quayside.
5. Any specific difficulties should be taken up with Capt. Ramsey, the Port Liaison Officer, who should without difficulty be able to make necessary adjustment.

6. If Capt. Ramsey is not able to make such an adjustment, it is requested that a report be rendered to this office by the Federazione of Naples, through Capt. Ramsey.

7. This matter is urgent and requires immediate action.
