1. Reference is made to the numerous telephone conversations relative to delayed arrival of disposal instructions for import cargo allocated to the Italian Government.

2. A recent case in point is 1620 tons of sugar on S/S "Garrett". The ship was pre-notified for Bari by at least three weeks. Yet, when berthing date arrived, Federazione Bari was still unable to get instructions from Rome. I finally called Federazione Rome myself, and they purported to be without knowledge of the shipment, in spite of the fact that the Bari branch had, to my knowledge, been pestering them for instructions. Finally, one day after the ship was ready to berth, the attached distribution was received. The result is that 1063 tons must be sent to Giovinazzo, warehoused and then re-shipped to destination.

3. It is not understood why this situation must continue. The expense and loss incident to multiple handling are known, as is the warehousing situation in this area. I should greatly appreciate being advised of the reason why arrangements cannot be made for the Ministry and Federazione, when they receive 21 or more days advance notice of arrivals, to notify us, 12 days prior to arrival, of the desired destinations.
