TO : ALCOM Port Liaison Officer - NAPLES

1. Advance advice has been received that the S.S. WARD HUNT, loaded with American Red Cross relief supplies, details of which are shown on the attached sheet, left the United States on 2 August and is expected to discharge in Naples.

2. It is expected that more detailed information will be given subsequently but in the event that the ship arrives without further advice from us, it is requested that this office be contacted by phone immediately, as Red Cross Headquarters in Rome desires to send a representative to Naples to assist in controlling the discharge.

3. The supplies are to be stored by Federazione Naples warehouses, subject to disposition by American Red Cross.
