1. Reference your letter dated 11 September 45.
2. Instructions have already been given for disposal of a part of the barley at Ancona. 2200 tons are programmed to be transferred to Venezia and Venezia Giulia Regions from 13 Sept. to 2 October. Another 600 tons will be programmed to move to Venice (for Venezia Region) the following period.
3. The remaining 975 tons are hereby allocated to Italian Government for distribution in the area served from Ancona. Please contact Ministry of Food for disposal instructions.
