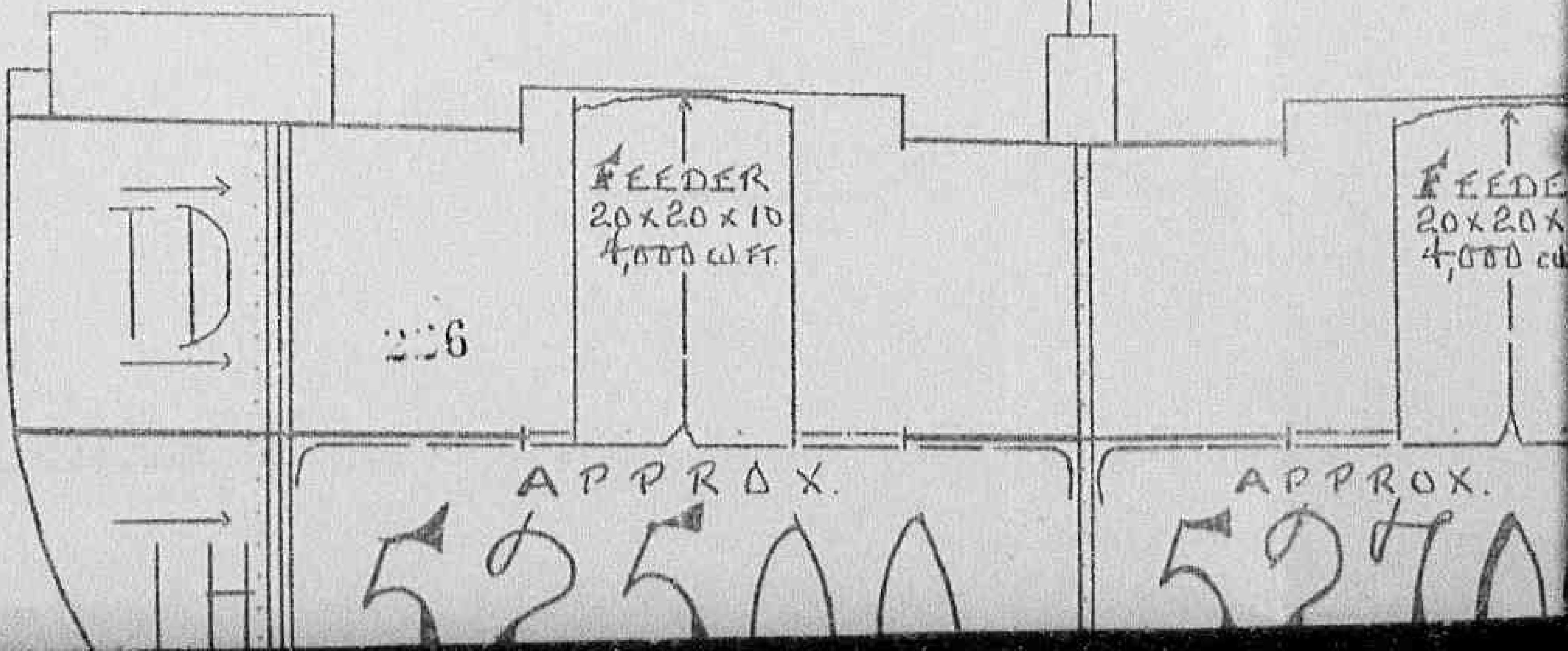

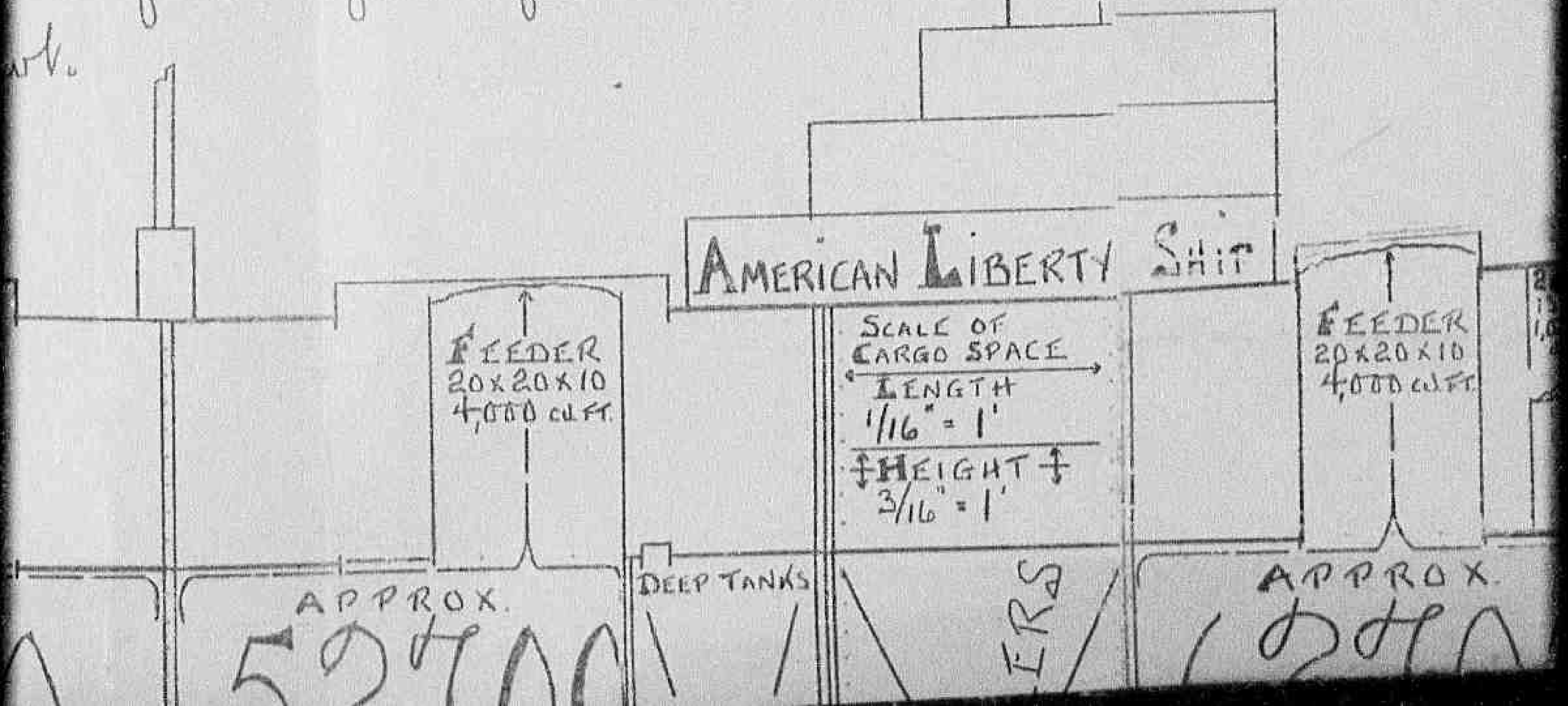

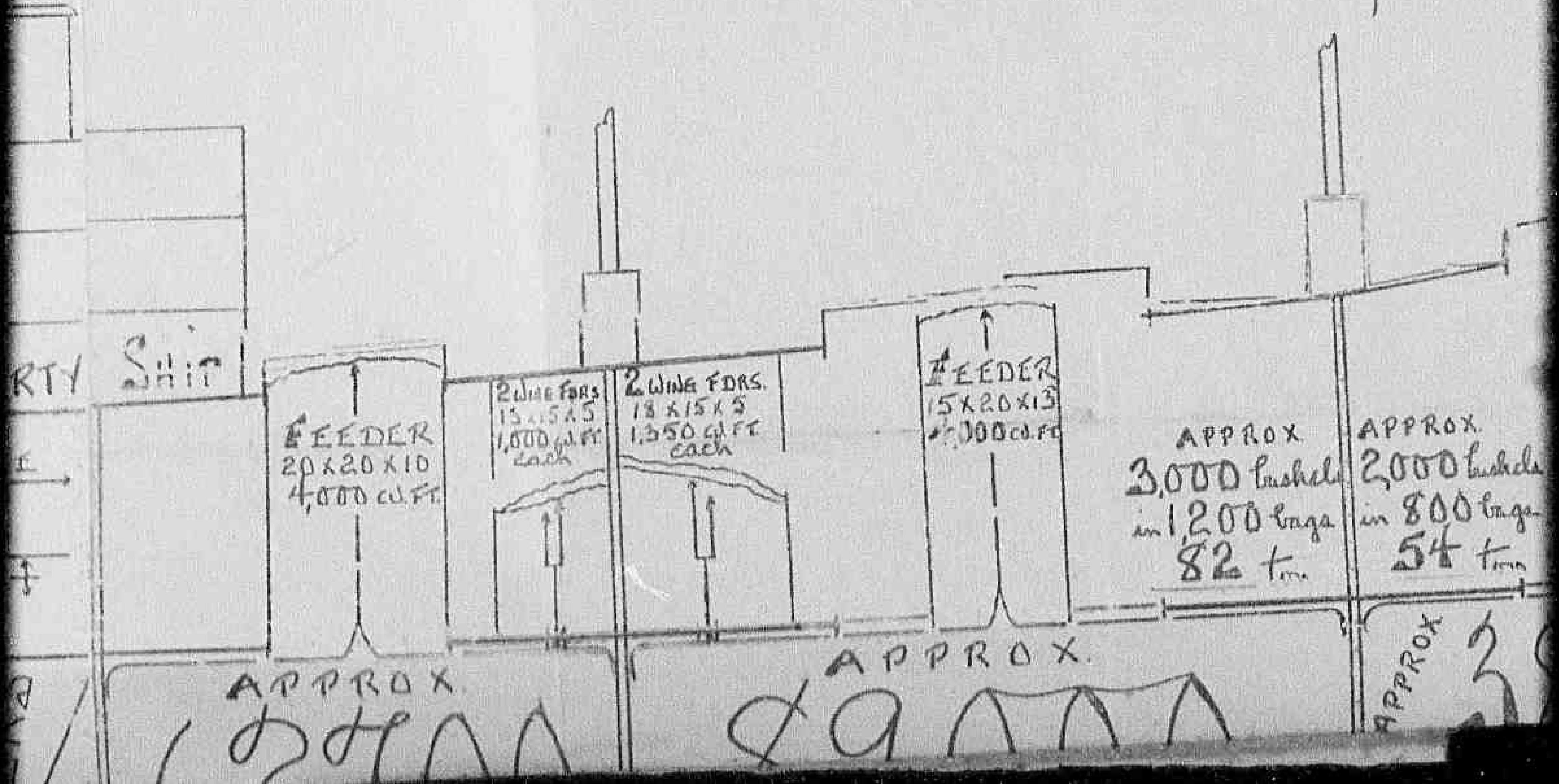

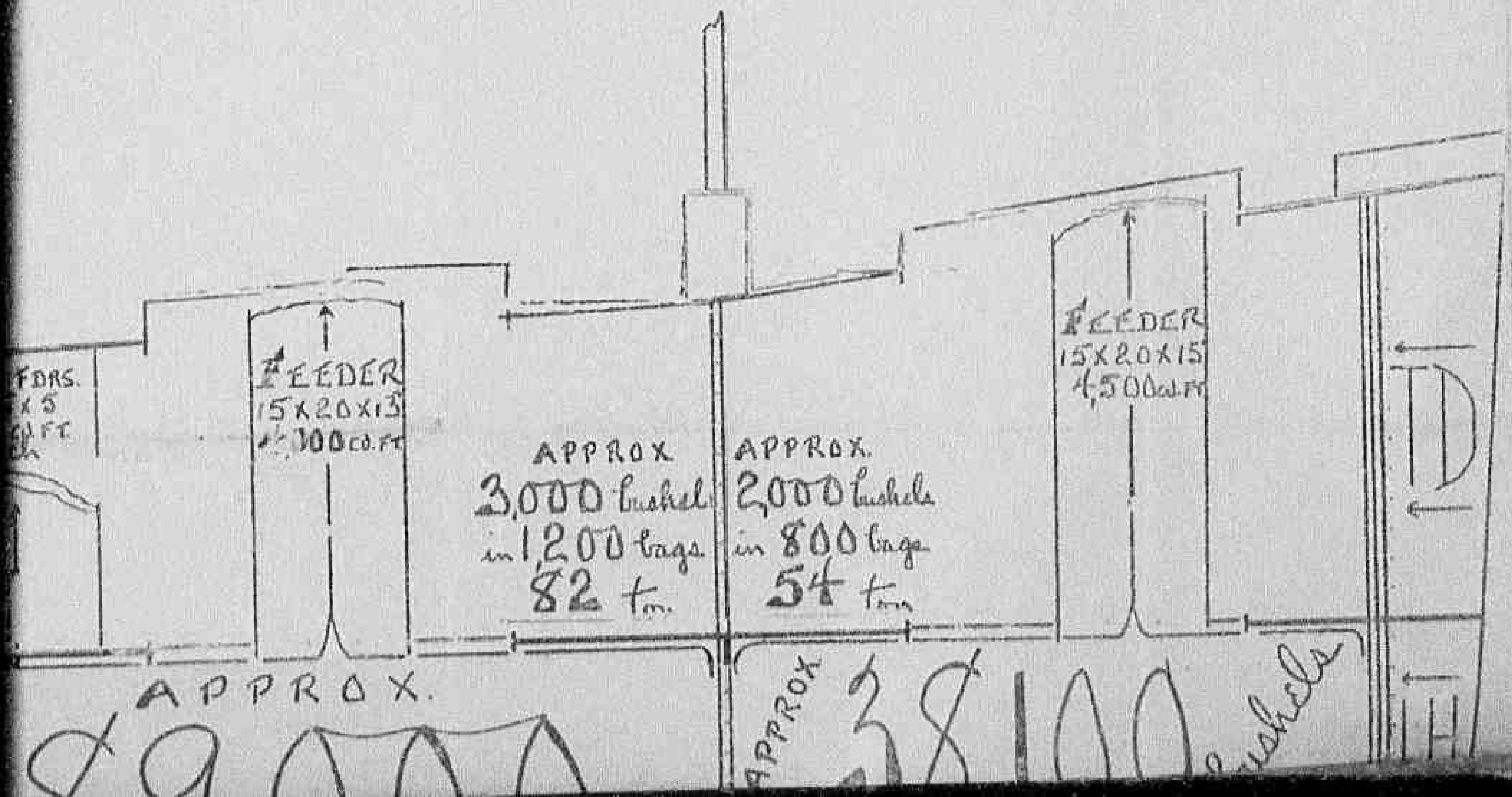


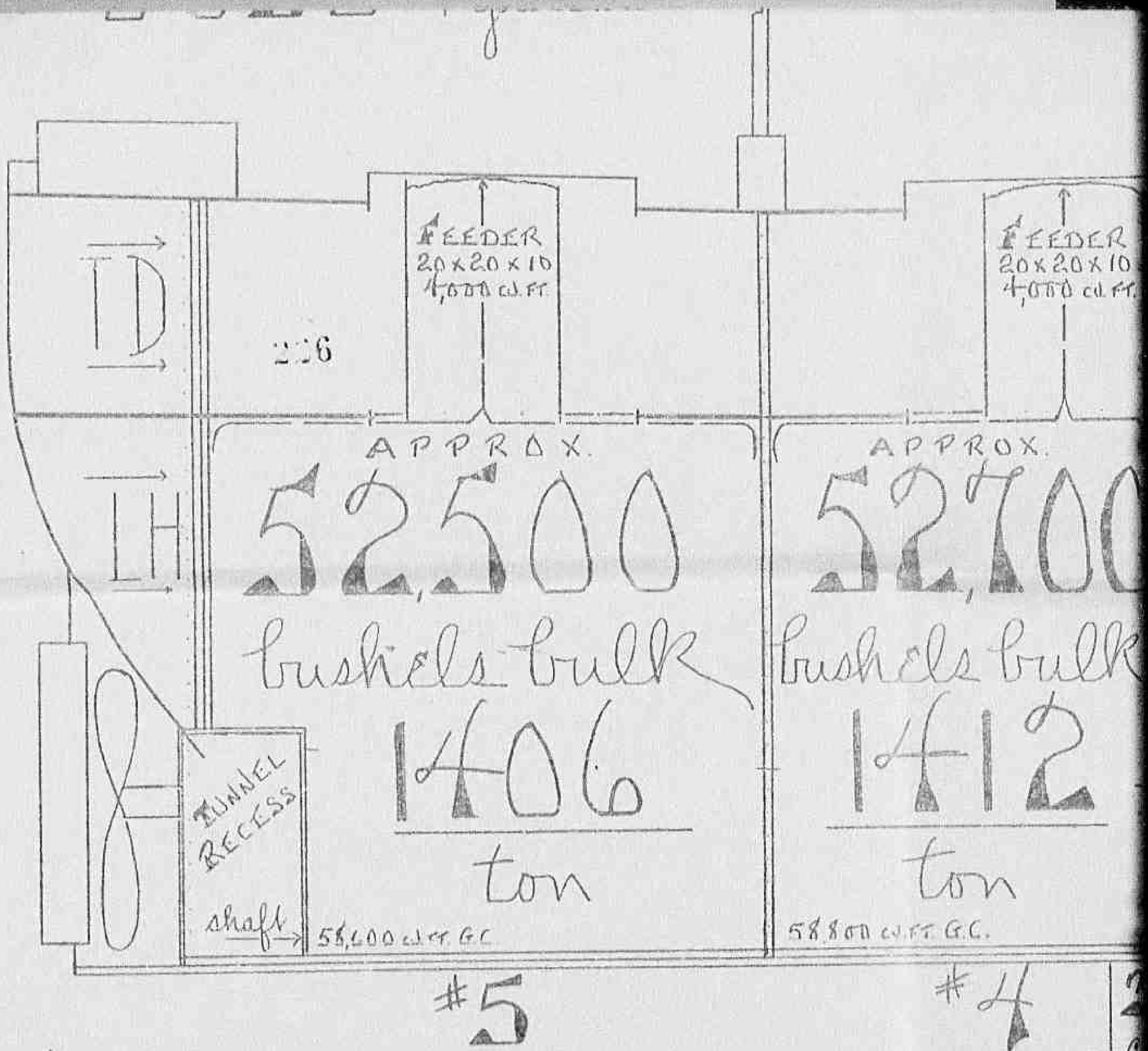
STORAGE PLAN

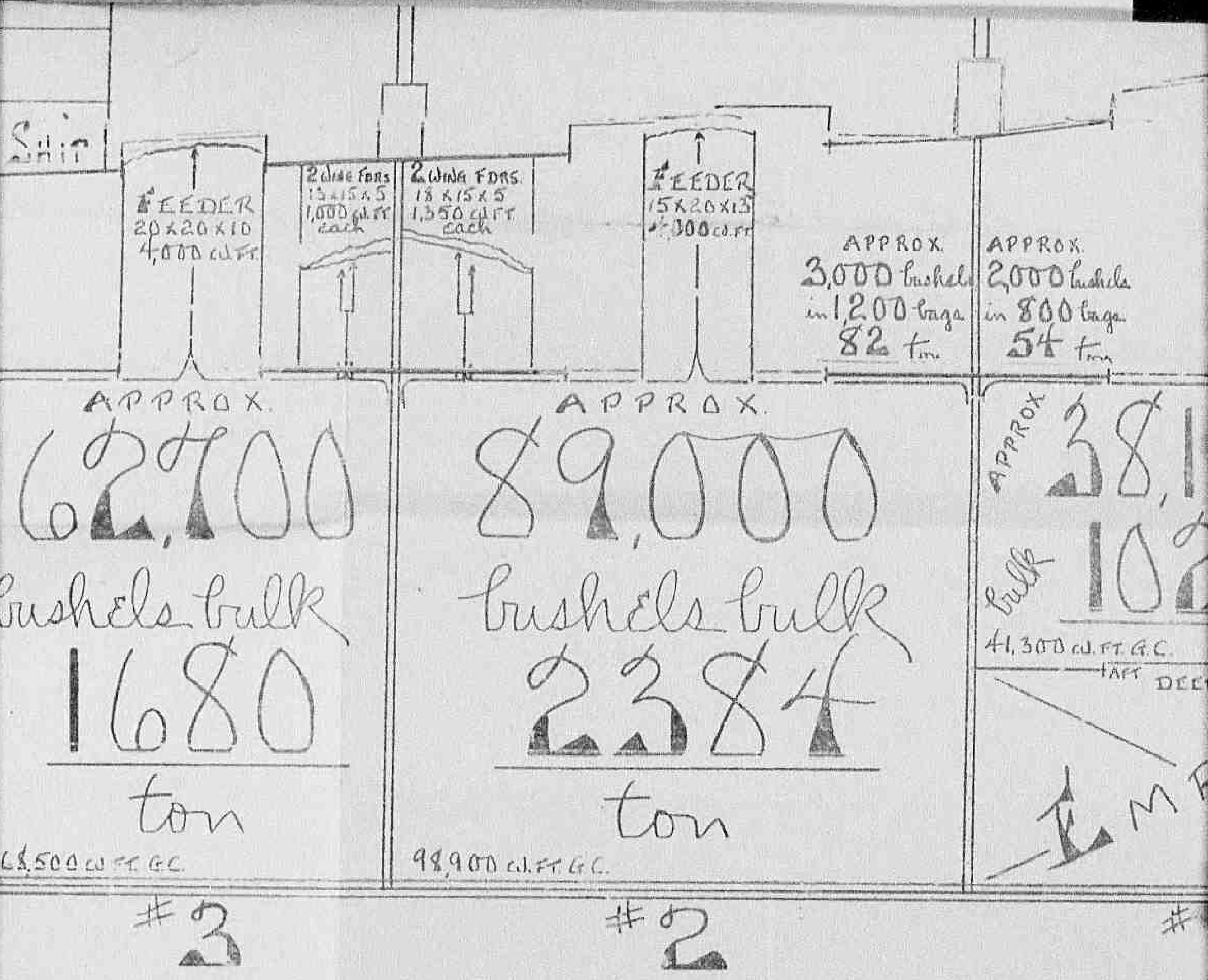

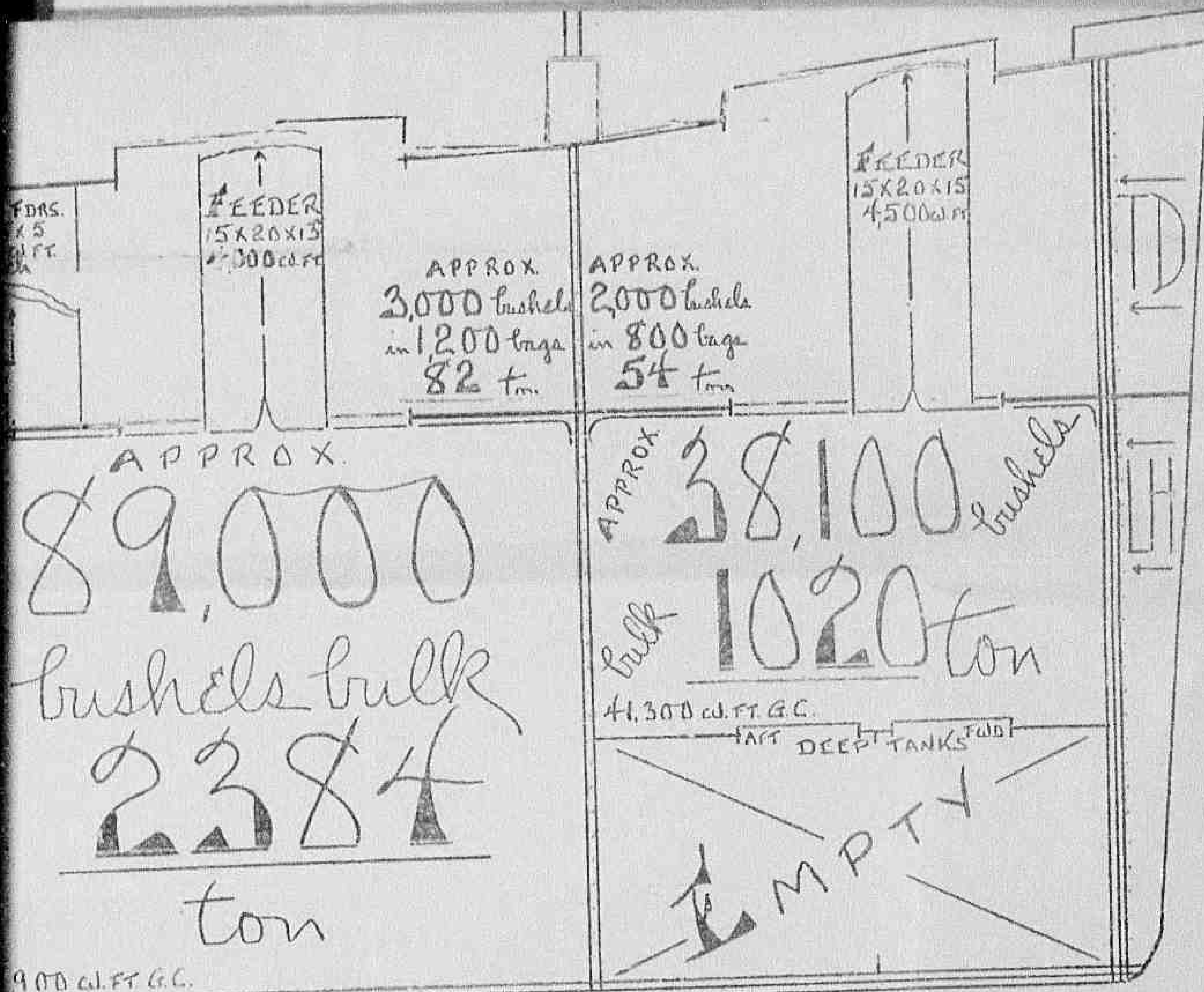
