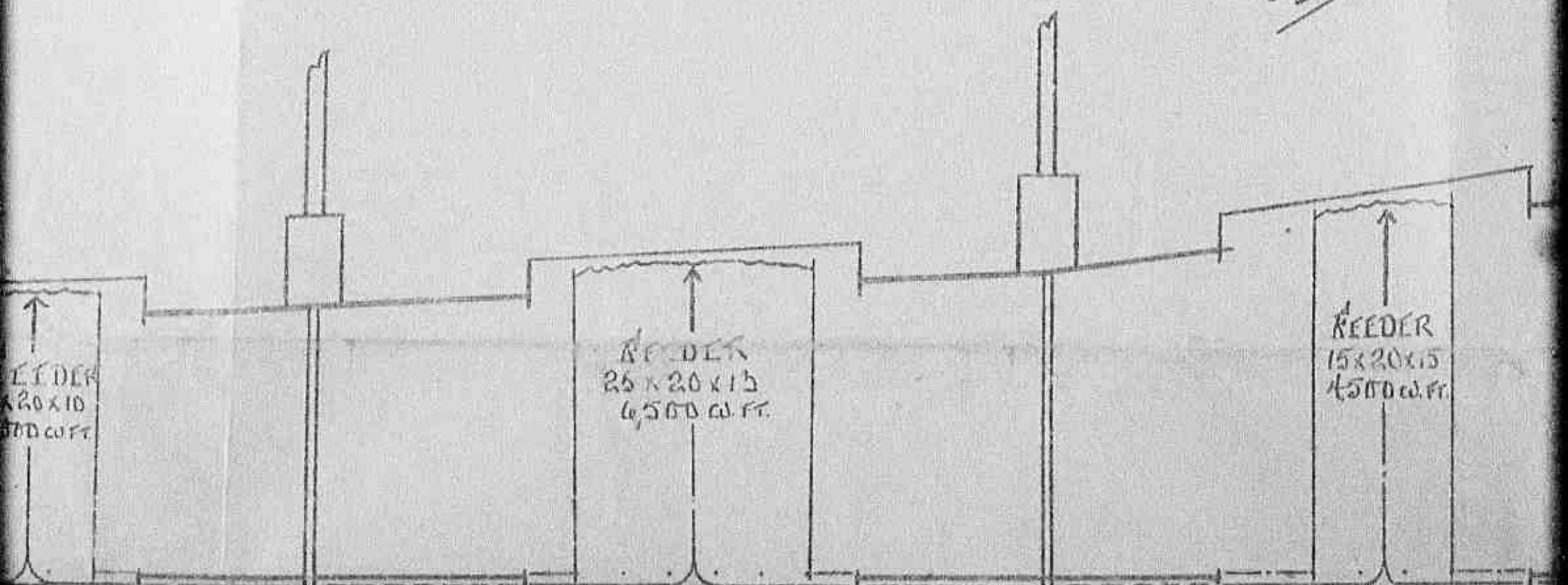
CARGO STOWAGE PLAN

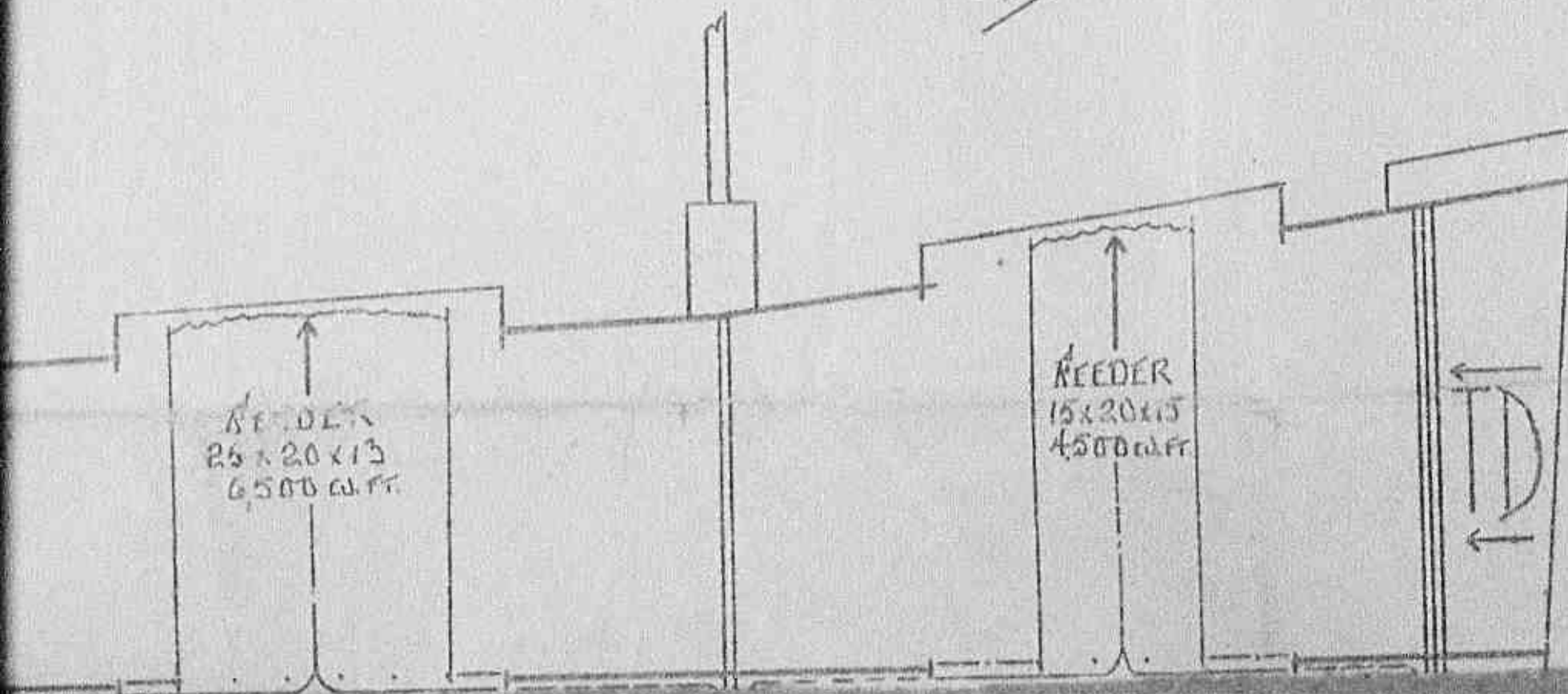


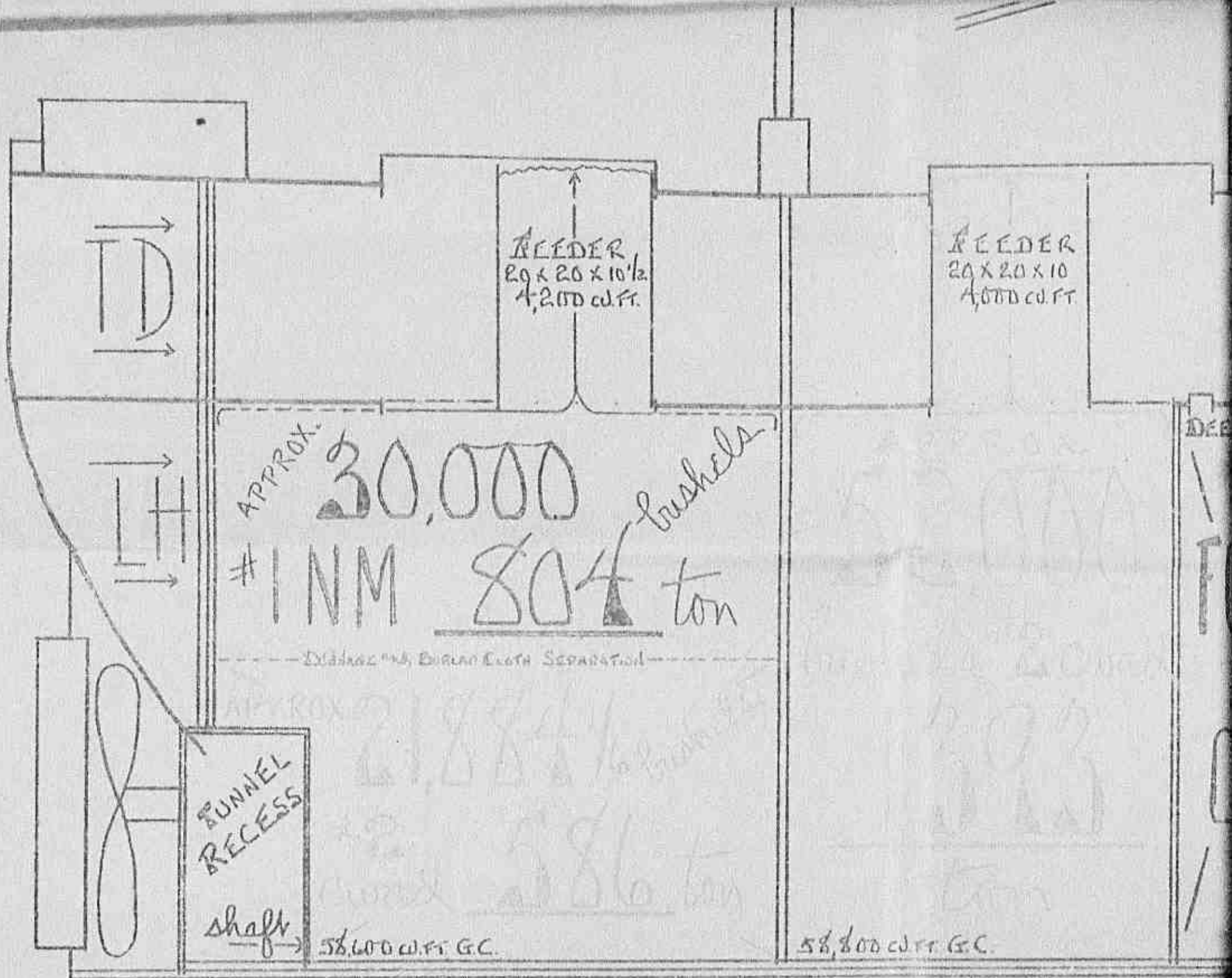
WAGE PLAN

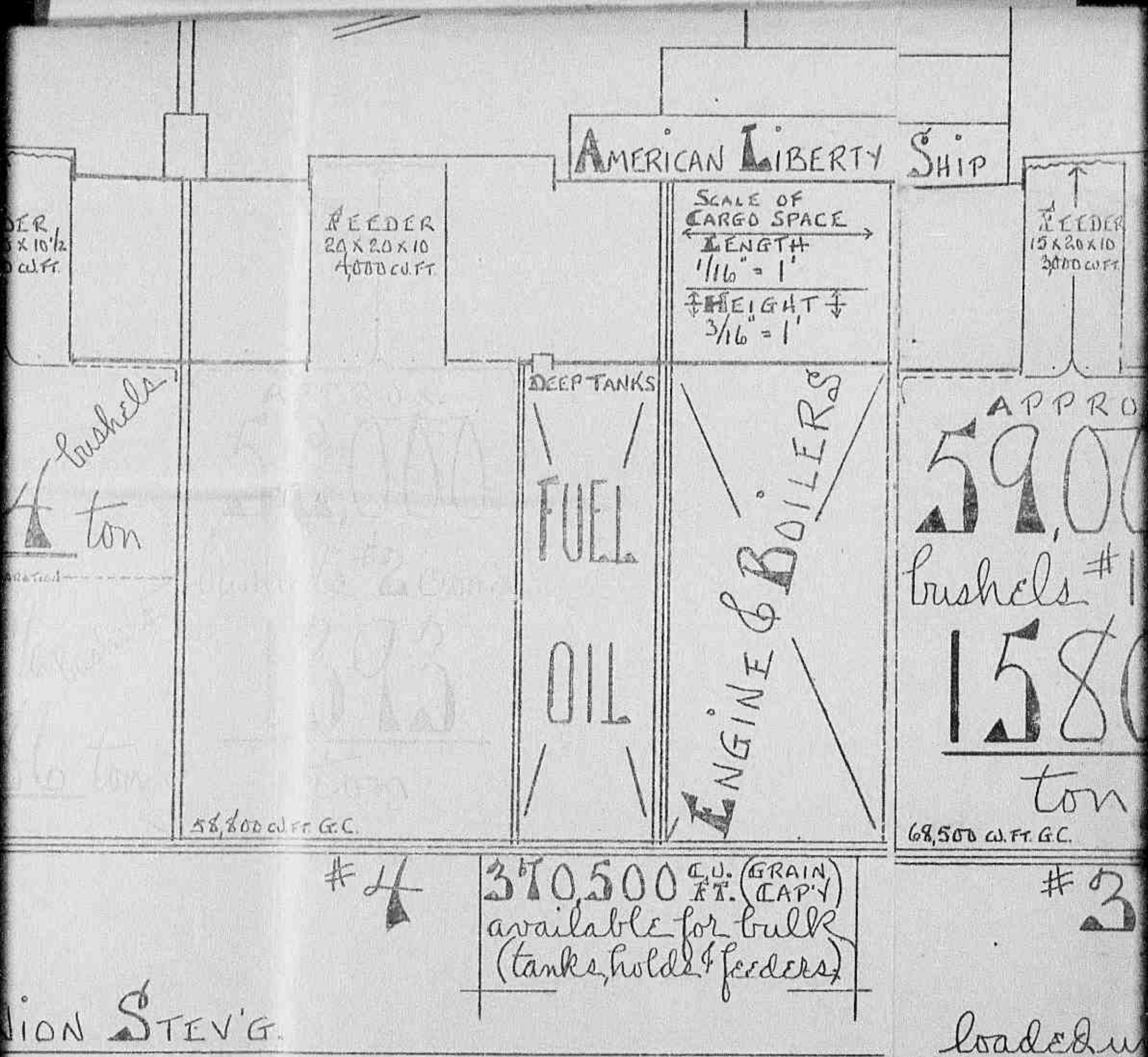

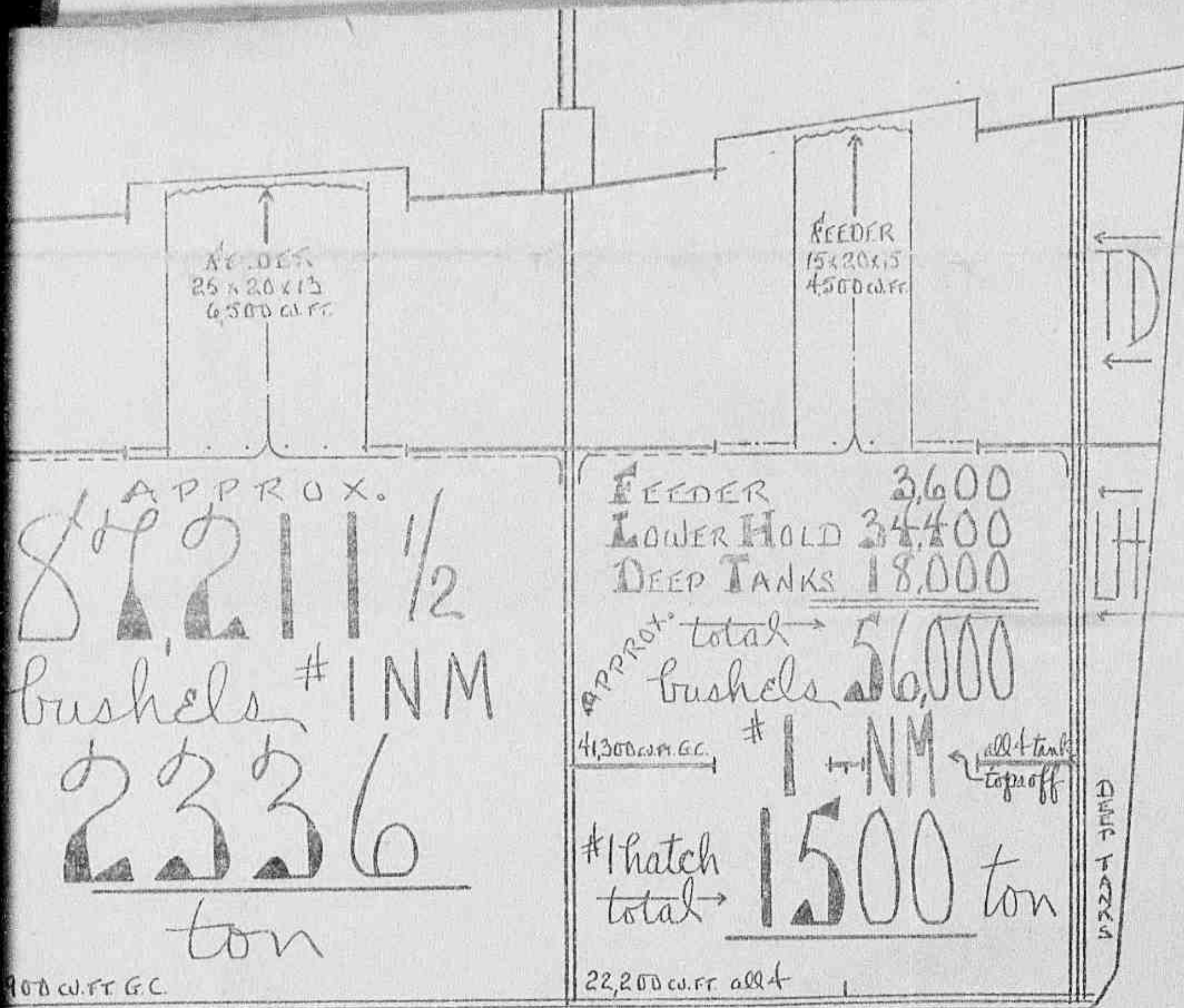
