1. In convoy U.G.C. 37 is vessel "WILLIAM JERMAIN" with army loco's for discharge at Naples.

2. Vessel also carries 8145 tons bulk wheat which A.F.H.C. have requested be discharged to A.C. port on West Coast, in view of loco's requiring to be off loaded at Naples.
