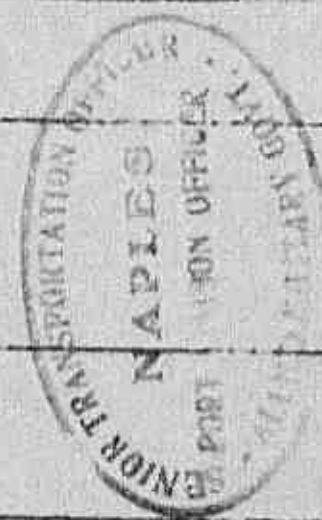

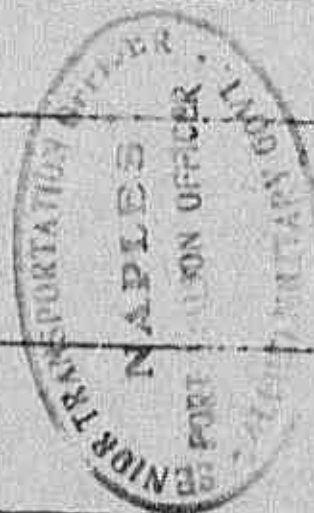

1. Tallies of your checkers fail to account for a/m supplies, although manifested and on stowage plan of the ship, and no reasonable explanation of the loss has been offered.

2. Agricultural S/C in Rome reports that one case of these goods has been turned in to them by M.P.O., a British unit in that area. A similar fate undoubtedly befall the remainder of the missing cargo.

3. The excuse that supplies manifested are not on board ship is seldom valid, and it seems probable in this case that your checkers failed to exercise due diligence in identifying the cargo and properly dispatching it.

4. Though ship has now departed, it is still possible to check stowage plan to ascertain disposal of other cargo stowed in the same hold, and to examine dispatch tickets carefully. Full facilities of the port are placed at your disposal, and every effort will be made to aid you in locating missing supplies.

5. When this has been done, please report your findings on Exhibit A & B of receiving report issued to Allied Commission as previously instructed.
