3. The newsprint will be shipped by water from Genoa within the next 60 days, more or less, and therefore should be stored where too much handling is not required.

4. You will be advised in advance when firm information is known. Manifests and disposition instructions will also be forwarded to you.

5. It is suggested that you make arrangements to secure for your own use the dunnage on these ships.
