SUBJECT: Salvage Machinery ex SS RARCH CAVIDOR

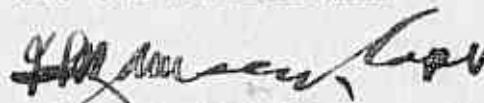
TO: ICE, Naples

1. Six cases of a/m cargo were misdelivered by port to Depot 290, MMIA, and, in accordance with the procedure in such cases, arrangements were made by this office to supply military transport for its collection and delivery to backpile 17 where it has been awaiting transshipment by rail for sometime. Your liaison representative was notified to have a checker at Depot 290, in order that the cargo could be tallied for re-loading and properly signed for, at 0800 hrs this morning.

2. Three military trucks were dispatched to depot and waited in vain for your checker to arrive. After two hours, trucks returned to the port empty.

3. Under the circumstances, we do not feel justified in asking for military transport to be redispached for this cargo and it will be necessary for you to make arrangements with MMAC for transport. This should be done immediately, as this and the remainder of cargo from this ship has long awaited shipment to Rome.
