1. The above firm with works at Leghorn, Fornace di Barga and Campo Tizzoro have approached this HQ both direct and also through the Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Labour with a view to the re-activation of their plants at Campo Tizzoro and Fornace di Barga for the production of non-ferrous materials for the electrical and transportation industries.

2. The products of this firm are of first importance to the general rehabilitation of Italian industries, and if at all possible, it is the desire of this sub-Commission to get the plants re-started. Briefly the firm's scheme is as follows:

a) Restart the mechanical shop and an electric furnace at Campo Tizzoro, using as raw materials brass and copper scrap which they contend can be supplied by their customers. They will produce copper and brass sheets for electrical needs, i.e. switches and meters etc.

b) Restart the plant at Fornace di Barga for the production of wire and wire rods.

In all some 1500 kW of electric power will be required at each plant and employment provided for approx. 1000 men.

3. We should be glad to have your views on the above proposals. Bearing in mind the importance of the industry and at the same

time giving your views as to the possibility of finding the necessary power and transportation to implement the scheme.

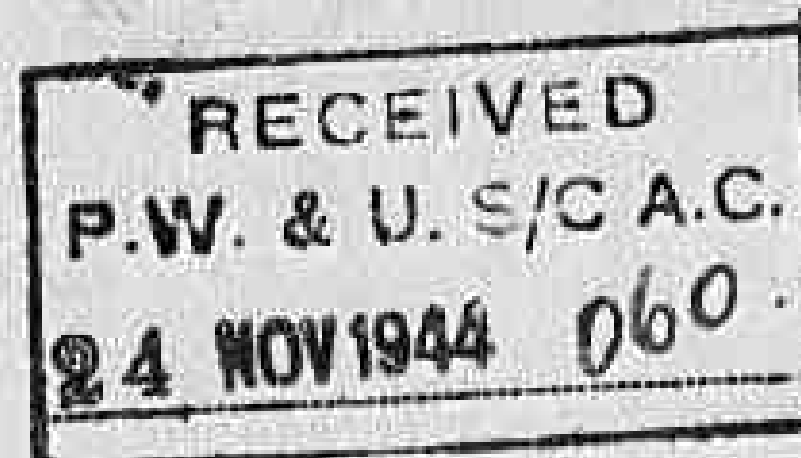

3) - Interruptions in service from 1330 hours to 2200 hours, each day, are due to the fact that the power supply for Rome is extremely short and large sections of the City had to be denied service during those heavy load hours. In addition the feeder cable which supplies the hospital has many non-essential users connected to it and the hospital has to suffer as a result.

4) - As the results of the new rationing scheme, now going into effect in Rome, are ascertained, it is hoped that this particular cable can be made "preferential". This depends, however, entirely on how well the non-essential customers on this line and in Rome respond to and cooperate with the rationing program.

5) - We have been assured that the service to this hospital will receive close attention on the part of the Engineers Section.

6) - It must be borne in mind, however, that there are likely to be future plant and line failures necessitating service interruptions to many establishments in Rome and Central Italy as all generating equipment and available lines are operated to capacity without any provision for break down reserves. In other words the demand for essential electric service will continue to exceed the available supply for an extended period of time.

1. Reference is made to our letter Ref: Mines-926.3, dated 19 September 1944.

2. It is requested that power for maintenance be released to these mines at the first possible moment. To safeguard the workings, the Cabernardi mine requires 200 KW. and the Perticora 150 KW. It will also be appreciated if you will give some indication as to the date when power for operations at Cabernardi is likely to be available at the rate requested in our letter of 14 Sept. 1944.

3. A feature of these sulphur mines is danger from underground fires which, if they break out, may render the mines inoperative for a considerable period, and, as is well known, the production of sulphur is of paramount importance not only to Italy but also to whole liberated Europe. Maintenance is essential but owing to the presence of noxious and inflammable gases the necessary work cannot be carried out without efficient ventilation.

4. Our latest information from the mines is as follows:

a. The Cabernardi Mine has no power at all. The mining company owns and operates a power plant at Serra San Quirico, sheet 14, S.205,290. This plant is in order and develops 200 KW. Formerly it supplied power to the UNES System and in return the Cabernardi mine received power from that system.

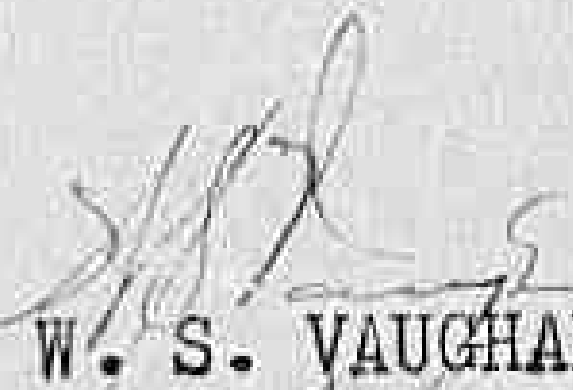

The management is in the unfortunate position of supplying power to the neighboring country and at the same time, running the risk of seeing their own mine wrecked through lack of power.

b. At Perticara Mine a 50 HP Diesel Set is intact while their 350 HP plant was completely destroyed. The mine is receiving sufficient fuel from military sources to keep the small set running. This mine for efficient maintenance requires 150 KW. as soon as the power position improves.

c. Nothing is known of the Formignano Mine in Forlì Province.

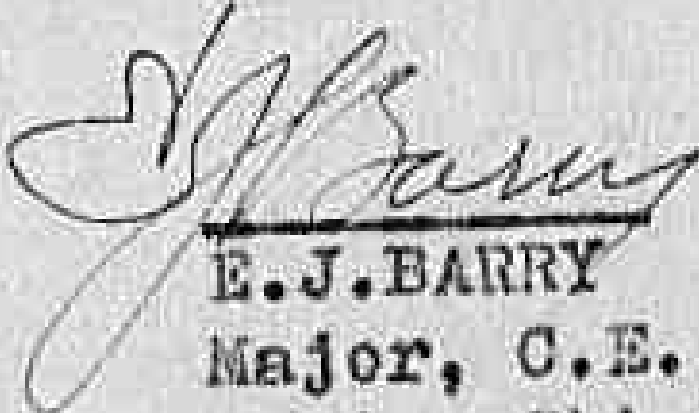

2. The operation of the port of CIVITAVECCHIA recently has been made the responsibility of the Italian Navy and Navy Sub-Commission, AC, has requested the Ministry of Marine to improve the port's facilities as soon as possible. 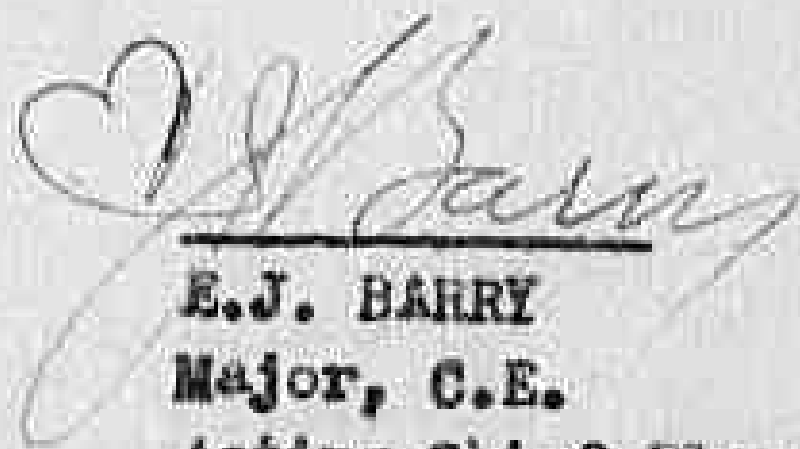

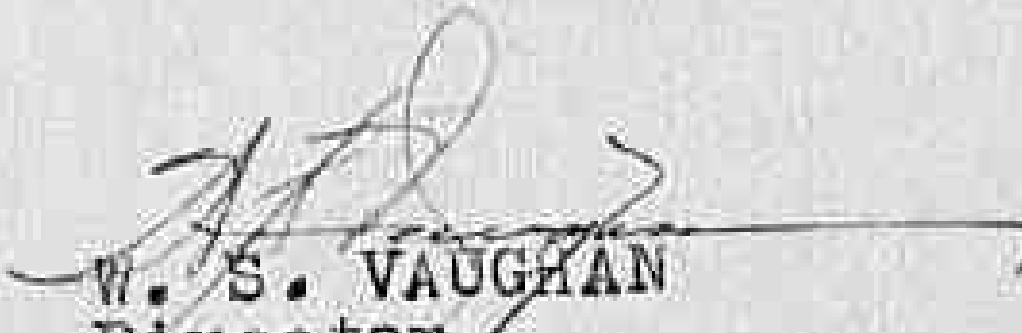

1. Letter, Allied Force Headquarters Advance Administrative Echelon, Central Mediterranean Force, file 59/8/22, dated 4 February 1944, subject: "Electricity Control", is rescinded, and in lieu thereof the following instructions apply.

2. The supply of electricity in occupied ITALY is limited, and strict control is essential in order that its use may be diverted to the war effort and not wasted. Bulk allocations of all electric power throughout the occupied mainland of ITALY are made at the monthly meetings of the electric Power Committee, on which you have membership.

3. The attached schedule, which will be revised each month, shows the limits of supply which will be made available in each area. The maximum peak demand is shown as well as the total consumption permissible. The controlling organization listed above are responsible for insuring that these figures are not exceeded.

4. The responsibility for local control with rest with the Military Commander in each area. Close coordination with the Local Allied Military Government - Allied Control Commission representative will be effected. The connected loads will be limited by restricting the number and size of new connections and by checking existing connections to see that they are not loaded beyond strict necessity. Non essential loads will be cut off completely. Steps will be taken to insure that electrical capacity available is allocated to essential military and civil needs. A list will be made in each area indicating the priority rating of all connections.

5. Arrangements as are necessary will be made to carry out a local system of control.

This Region is already to take over control
of electricity supplies but we are not entirely in agreement
with your suggested boundary between this Region and Southern
Region, viz. the line of the M. Sangro with the area bounded by
CANTERA-PRIDIA-LANCIONE-CEZAGROSA-POSSACERIA going to Southern
Region.

The present boundary between Southern Region and
this Region is the provincial boundary between CANTERA and
CHIETI Provinces. While it is true that power from the Calabrian
Stations is distributed north of this line through the ANI network,
this distribution is not limited to the territory south of the
boundary you propose but extends north to PESCARA, TERNI and
(ultimately) to ABRUZZO Provinces.

Moreover actual control of connections to
users throughout CHIETI Province will be exercised by the 158th S.
Director at PESCARA and, judging by past experience, confusion
will result if he receives instructions from two ANI/AC sources.

If, as you state, military requirements are now
practically nil, consumers of the bulk of the power will be civilian

and a matter of direct concern to the Provincial Commissioner of CHIANTI Province. It would introduce many difficulties were this officer dependent upon technical advice and assistance from the Engineering Division of a Region other than his own for a part of his territory, particularly as assistance is generally required at short notice and the Southern Region headquarters are some distance from CHIANTI.

We would suggest that the existing Regional boundary be maintained for purposes of Electricity supply control or even that the Regional Engineer of this Region should extend his control to cover the whole of the UNES District directed from PISCARA. This would take him into Southern region and is open to the same objections raised above.

It is therefore suggested that the best way to settle this matter of boundaries would be a meeting at your ^{office} attended by the Regional Engineer of the two Regions concerned.

If you concur may we please have three or four ^{days} notice of the proposed date of the meeting. As we attend a weekly conference on electrical matters in Arezzo every Tuesday a date falling in the second half of the week would suit better if equally convenient to others.

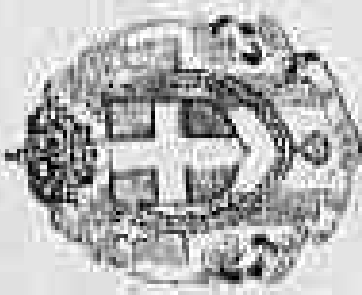

1. Pursuant to the conversation held with Capt. Laughlin on 6 November 1944, request is made for electric power for the Carbon Bisulphide Plant of the Soc. Umbra Prodotti Chimici, at Collestatte, TERNI.

2. Carbon bisulphide is of the greatest importance to the Italian economy in the following order of priority:

- a. the preservation of grain, legumes and other foodstuffs;
- b. the extraction of olive oil for food and soap;
- c. the manufacture of rayon textiles.

At present the supply of carbon bisulphide in Italy is critical and the necessity for the early resumption of its manufacture cannot be over emphasized.

3. The plant at Collestatte has eight electrically operated retorts, each of which can produce approximately 135 m. tons per month. This Sub-Commission was advised by the owners on 5 November 1944 that four retorts were operable immediately upon supply of electric power. However, due to the difficulty attendant the supply of sulphur (transportation) it is proposed to put one retort into operation upon supply of electric power.

4. The electric power characteristics of the retort are briefly as follows:

- a. Initial heating period.
The power input rises steadily from 100 KW the first day until it reaches 800 KW on the tenth day.
- b. Intermediate period.
On the tenth day power input falls sharply and within two days the power input required is 600 KW.
- c. Operational period.
Thereafter for the duration of operation which averages 150 days, the current demand fluctuates narrowly around 600 KW.

5. For the reasons stated in paragraph 2, electric power sufficient for the operation of one retort at Collestate, TERNI, is requested; power to be turned on 15 December 1944 and to be continuous.

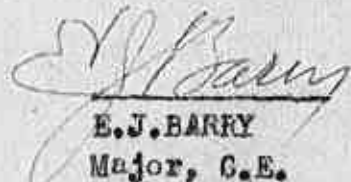
