3. Considering the hardship that will arise due to the inability of "Dopolavoro" to carry out their program would it be possible to relax the power restriction so that their Cinema could continue to function.

The electric power situation is very critical just at this time and it has been necessary to interrupt the service to one half of Rome with some variation on alternate days in order to keep the situation under control and not endanger generating machinery and equipment. As a result many important establishments are being affected including military.

3. Steps have already been taken in an endeavor to improve the situation in Rome and in Central Italy but it will take several days before results will begin to be felt.

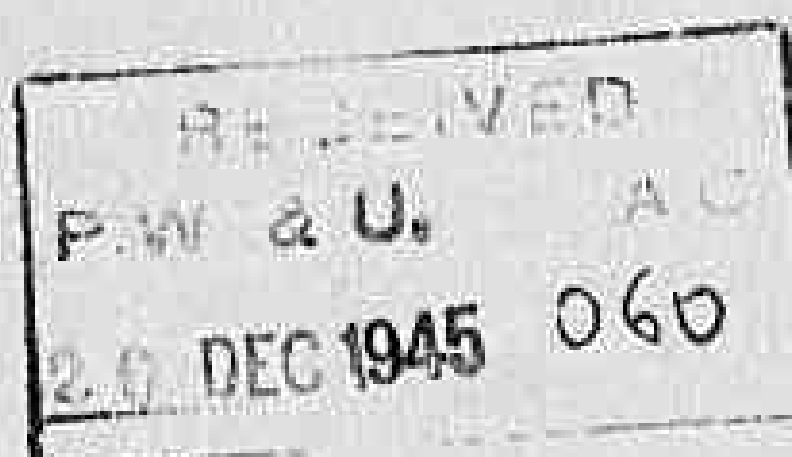

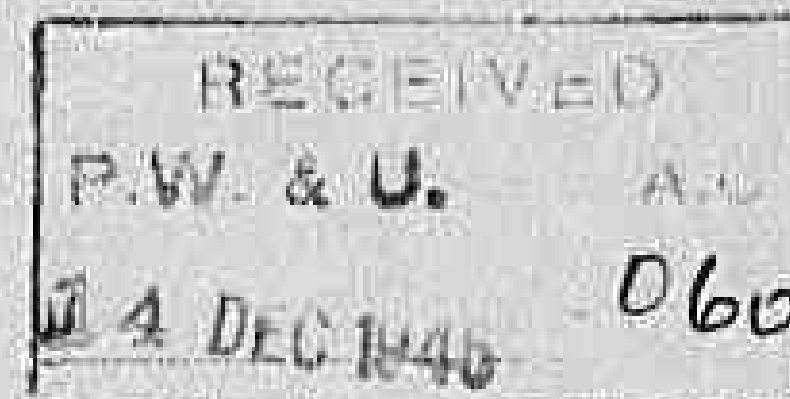

1. We are informed that the Poligrafico dello Stato of Via Gino Capponi, Roma has been more than 50% without power in the last ten days, with consequent interference with output.

2. The Poligrafico is engaged on printing Food Ration Cards for the whole of Italy, which ration cards have to be distributed during the first two/three weeks of January. Unless the cards are distributed in time the rationing system is endangered.

3. The Ministry of Food has been requested to take the matter up direct with the Ministry supervising electric power, and it is desired that your Sub-Commission also point out the seriousness of the matter and recommend that full power be provided to the Poligrafico in order it may fulfil its commitment.

For your information the total amount of peak load for street lighting in all provinces of Puglia was of ab. 2000 KW in pre-war times, which means that the actual load to be added would be of ab. 400 KW.-

As to the quantity of lamps, the number installed in pre-war time was around 50.000 - The number to be now installed, for all the region, would be of about 17.000 -

The quantity left in our stores would be just sufficient for one first installation and one only replacement, with the above reduced number - By considerably reducing the number of lighting hours, it would be possible to keep the service for about six months -

Applications have been already filed by our company with the Chambers of commerce (Ufficio Provinciale Ind. & Commercio) of each Province for new supplies of lamps -

Above trouble traced to sudden increase in load on Central Italy Grid. Checks were made with A.C.I.A. Company and Control indicating that the trouble was not local in character. Called Maj. Bruce and gave him the information. He stated that the situation on voltage was better today and they were not having as much trouble. Also called Col. Carnes office.

Electric Power Tension - As it is known, at present, the assembling of the trucks in this Workshop has frequent interruptions owing to the low frequency of electric power that from 220 Volts descends down to 160 and sometimes down to 150-140 Volts. This ~~has~~ hampers considerably the ~~functioning~~ functioning of automatic machinery and above all the transport transporting and lifting cranes which have a great importance in this kind of work.
