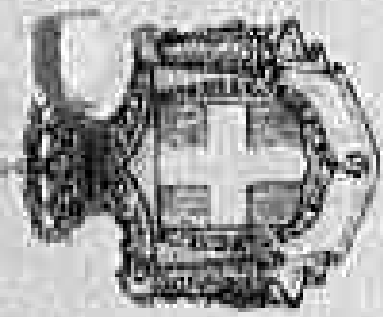

SUBJECT : Military Contractors Petrol Coupons

TO : S & T Branch
G.H.Q. C.M.F.

1. Reference is made to the system in force under which Petrol is supplied by C.I.P. to Civilian contractors working for Allied Military against special Petrol Coupons.

2. It is understood that in the past settlement between C.I.P. and military authorities has been effected by means of book-keeping entries and this has been possible as C.I.P.'s stock has been maintained solely by releases from military.

3. As from 1 Feb 46 it is pointed out that C.I.P. will be receiving stocks by direct importation which have been financed by UNHRA funds. It is no longer practical, therefore, for C.I.P. to accept a paper credit as outlined in para 2 and if the system of issuing military coupons is to continue physical refunds of stocks borrowed must be arranged.

4. This S/C feels that the time has come for this whole system to be re-examined with a view to setting up an alternative channel of supply for such military contractors as are still operating and requests that appropriate action be taken.

It would also be useful if an indication could be given of quantities of POL needed to complete contracts in course so that the Ital. Govt. can plan their allocations accordingly.

SUBJECT: P.O.L.

TO : Ing. Luigi Ferretti, Ministry of Public Works

1. I have taken up the matter of fuel for the delivery of trucks to Catanzaro, Bologna, and Palermo and the matter of fuel for the 10 jeeps and 20 new 3-ton trucks with the Chief, Engineering Division, P.W. & U. S/C. He has promised that he will look into the situation and will try to find out why it is not possible for you to draw gasoline in Rome for this purpose. He states that Bologna has been supplied with a large block of coupons and that it is indicated that they will be able to draw sufficient fuel. This Office has asked for requests from your various offices in the field through your Office for P.O.L. coupons, and this Office has promised to supply such coupons. To date with the exception of Aquila, no such requests have been received. If you will carry through with our request of some time ago and let us have requests for fuel for the various offices in the field, we shall see that they are supplied.

2. We will advise you of any information received from Major Hyland promptly.

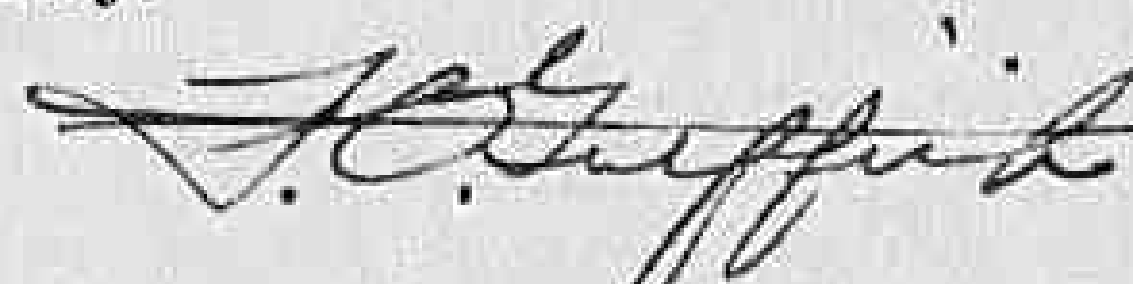

SUBJECT: Brake Fluid and Glycerin

TO : Public Works & Utilities S/C

1. We are receiving requests for hydraulic brake fluid and glycerin for various equipment using these types of material for hydraulic systems. This material has never been obtainable nor has it been furnished with equipment received. The equipment may not be operated without it. This is particularly true in the case of truck equipment using hydraulic brake fluid and graders using glycerin in their control mechanisms. It is requested that a source of supply be located and a method of requisitioning be instituted whereby this Office may be in a position to obtain the material as quickly as possible. It is estimated that we shall require approximately 2 50-gallon drums of brake fluid and 4 50-gallon drums of glycerin immediately.

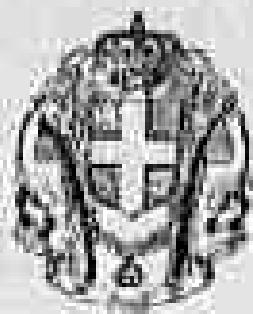

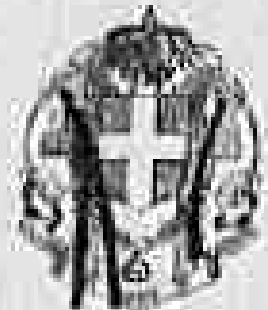

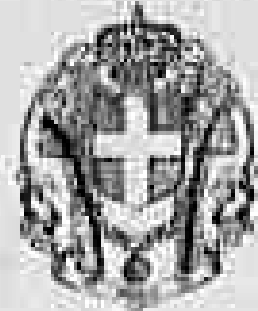
