1. The Genio Civile, NAPLES Area have been responsible for making two bridge contracts on the NAPLES - AVELLINO Road (Route 7bis) and allowing the contractor to proceed with extensive excavations on this AFHQ Priority Route without approval of plans or authority to proceed with the work.

2. Assuming that the Regional Engineer's office have not initiated these works without reference to this office, the Genio Civile are now ignoring the responsible military authority. As I am finally responsible for all essential military roads in 3 District I must be satisfied that this intolerable state of affairs is dealt with in such way as to eliminate any recurrence.

3. The Genio Civile, NAPLES Area have now been submitting plans of reconstruction works for approval for over a year and ignorance or misunderstanding cannot be accepted as reasonable excuse.

It is more than significant that in one case a scheme for new bridge was rejected and secondly a similar proposal for another site not even submitted for approval; whilst eventually the work at both sites proceeds without further reference to this office.

4. Copies of correspondence are attached hereto and details of unauthorised work are summarised as follows :-

In view of the proposed withdrawal of the AC Road Organisation it is imperative that the Genio Civile realise that the control of military highways has not been passed to them, and, subject to your enquiries, I suggest that the only effective disciplinary action in this case is the dismissal of Signore Mancini and any other Genio Civile official involved.

1. Ref letters CMF.128 and CMF.129 dated 21 Feb 45., it would appear from these replies that a complete misunderstanding exists concerning the direction and approval of new works on military roads.

Although paras I & II ('Responsibility Category 'A' Roads' and Final Responsibility) in "Roads Organisation and Policy" memo CE.4503 dated 12 Dec 44 make the position quite clear.

2. The final responsibility for all road and bridge work on military routes rests with CE 3 District.

3. Any complaints concerning delay of civilian engineers are always in respect of approved works initiated by CE 3 District or the GARE and the Genio Civile can only put forward for approval schemes for bridge reconstruction but cannot excavate a military highway for culvert or bridge reconstruction even to alleviate flooding, without permission from the responsible military authority or approval of the design, which will depend upon whether such work is considered essential from a military aspect.

4. Plans and further information are required for the unauthorised excavation at S.SOSSIO Bridge, Route 7(b) Km 45+940 and no work will commence at PONTE SCHITO Route 7, Km 237+550 until plans for the limited work as suggested in para.3 of CE.4513 dated 19 Feb 45 are approved.

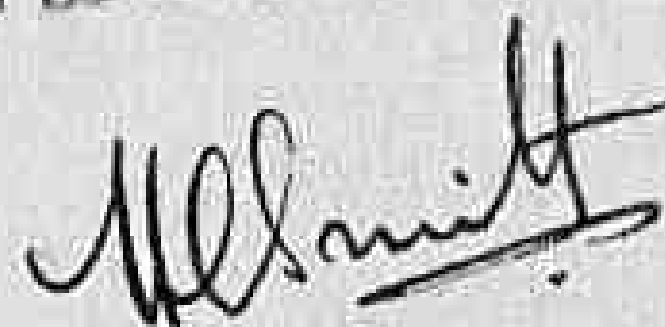

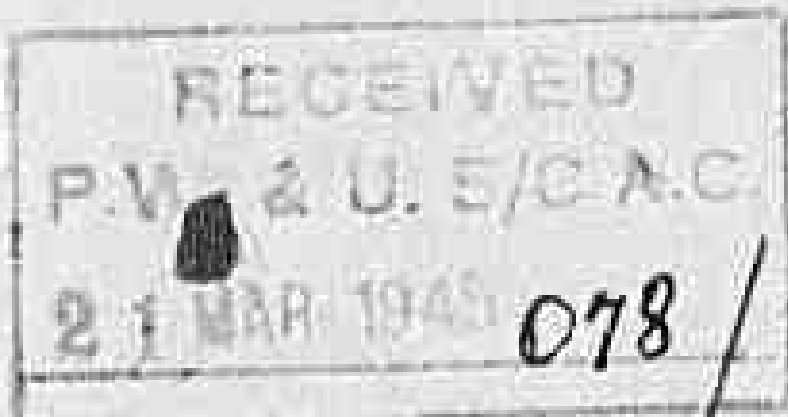

1. In compliance with request contained in your letter of 7 March 1945, arrangements are being made with the Genio Civile for the preparation of plans and estimates for the reconstruction of the bridge over the Volturno River at Capua.

2. Some months ago a project was approved in this HQ for the removal of debris from the river channel so as to diminish the danger of flood damage to the existing timber bridge. This work is in progress and will be completed in the near future.

3. Pending receipt of a definite recommendation from P.B.S., this reconstruction had not been included in our program due to the following factors:

- (a). Good condition of existing timber bridge.
- (b). Readiness of the old Ponte Romano site to receive a Bailey bridge in case of emergency.
- (c). Existing policy of undertaking only the most vital work due to current exorbitant cost of construction and shortage of competent contractors.

4. Plans for the new structure will be presented to you for approval before a contract is awarded.

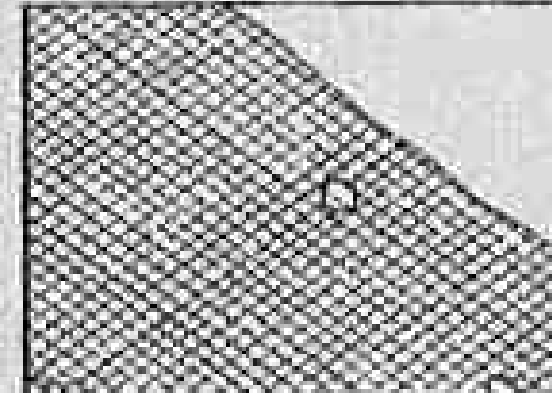
