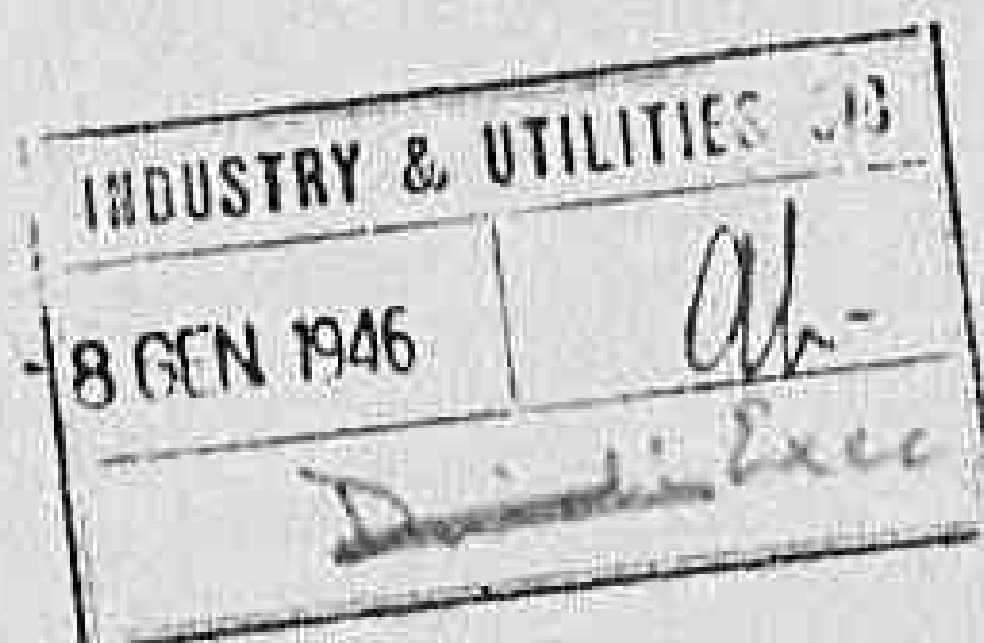

1. Under the provisions of letter AG 200.6/880 A-O MTOUSA, 21 September 1945, it is recommended that William Knight, M.C. (141159) Lieutenant Colonel, Essex Regiment British Army, Regional Engineer Venezia Region, A.M.G., Allied Commission be awarded the Medal of Freedom with silver palm for exceptionally meritorious conduct in the performance of outstanding services from February 1944 to 30 November 1945.

2. Lieut. Colonel Knight then a captain joined the Allied Commission at Tizi Ouzou 23 September 1943. He was assistant to the director Public Works and Utilities Sub-Commission at Palermo Sicily from 16 October 1943 until mid - February 1944.

On 6 January 1944 his promotion to the grade of major became effective.

3. In February 1944 he was placed in charge of military highways in Region 2 and on 4 June 1944 became Regional Engineer of this region, with headquarters at Bari.

Lt. Colonel Knight, then major, demonstrated exceptional ability and foresight in accomplishing the reconstruction of highways and other public works.

He was officially commended by the Chief Engineer, for his work in that area.

His next assignment was as Regional Engineer of Venezia Region in October 1944 but at his own request he was attached to the Toscana Region in order to devote his services more advantageously in the tasks of reconstruction and rehabilitation of public works.

He also lent his services in Emilia Region where there was so much destruction from war operations.

4. On 7 February 1945 Lieut. Colonel Knight, then major, was released from attachment with Toscana and assumed the duties of Civil Affairs Officer and Regional Engineer Venezia Region as the 8th Army advanced into that region.

Lieut. Colonel Knight, then major, has exercised commendable tact, excellent foresight, manifested sound judgment, superior technical skill, straightforward impartiality and has encouraged and supported agencies of the Italian Government to assume the responsibilities and duties in carrying on the essential works initiated so as to avoid interruption or unnecessary delays when full responsibility for these operations is assumed by the Italian Government.

5. He has accepted personal responsibility without hesitation in carrying out the tasks with which he was confronted some peculiar only to his Region.

His devotion to duty and accomplishments reflect the highest credit upon himself, the Allied Commission and the Allied Forces in Italy and his efforts have contributed materially to the United States and the Allied cause.

His promotion to Lieutenant Colonel became effective 27 August 1945.

6. As evidence of his ability there is attached a copy of a commendation from the commanding General of the XIII Corps.

7. It is recommended that the MEDAL OF FREEDOM with the silver palm be awarded to Lieutenant Colonel William KNIGHT as a token of acknowledgment for the outstanding accomplishments that he has attained in carrying out his mission.

2. Complete description of action: In case of service awards such as Legion of Merit, a complete description of a service rendered in detail should be listed. In recommendation for other awards, a detailed and factual description of the incident is of utmost importance. Do not use general statements. The most common error in recommendations is that they do not contain enough detail.

3. In recommendations for combat decorations, specific information should be included as nearly as reasonably possible, regarding each of the following (using operations maps, narrative statement, and any other convenient form):

- f. Effects or results of deed in question, etc.

4. Statement as to personal knowledge of the initiating officer. If he has no personal knowledge of the incident or service rendered, two affidavits from eye witnesses or persons having knowledge must be inclosed.

5. Each basic recommendation for the award of a decoration will show the exact status of the person who is being recommended at the time of rendition by him of the service upon which the recommendation is based. Grade and assignment at the time of the incident or at the time service was rendered as well as the grade and assignment at the time recommendation is made.

6. Statement that entire subsequent service of individual since performance of act cited has been honorable. In case of Distinguished Service Medal or Legion of Merit recommendation, statement that the individual has completed his service in the position or that it was substantially complete at time he was transferred to other duty should be added.

7. List of previous awards to include general order and headquarters of issue.

8. Proposed Citation, which will include: a. Name, Arm of Service, Grade, Organization, period of time (inclusive dates) of service rendered, and the general or specific locality or campaign.

b. A condensation of the letter of recommendation including all pertinent facts upon which award is based. When award is made, only the citation is published in orders; therefore, a resume of the act or service rendered must be in sufficient detail to justify the award.

c. The last sentence will include the individual's home town and state of time of enlistment, induction, entry into West Point, or present home address. (In case of Posthumous, Missing in Action, or Prisoner of War awards, include name and relationship of nearest relative, house number, street or rural route, city and state).

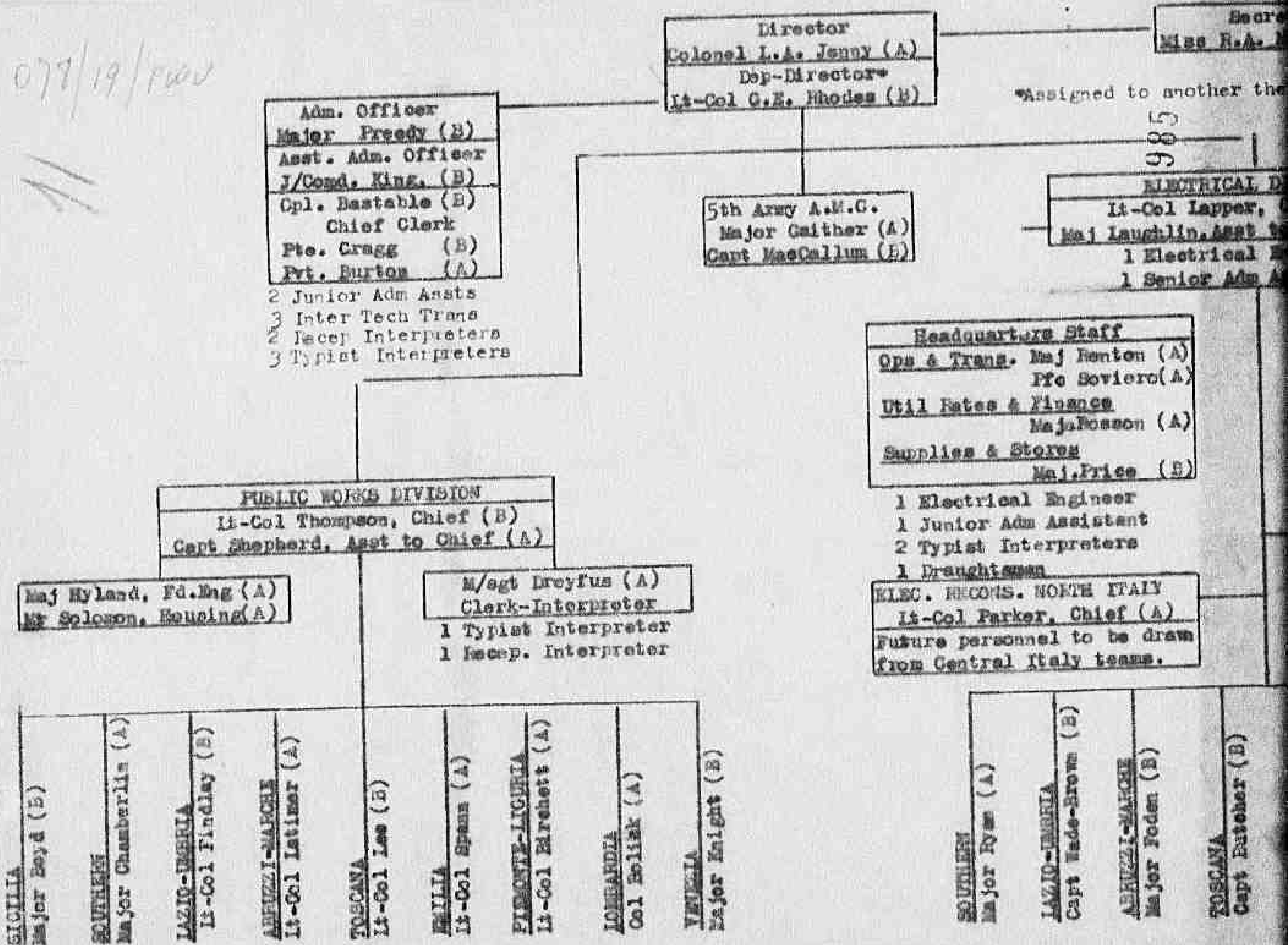

These figures include a Regional Engineer for each of the Regions except Liguria which will be a responsibility of the Regional Engineer of Piemonte. Activities to be organized and supervised by the above personnel include Military and Civil Highways and Bridges, sewers, water works, ports, public buildings and bonifiche.

2. The estimate of personnel requirements for the Northern Regions is based on the following factors:

(a). Experience and knowledge of work volume gained in the operation of Southern and Central Italy Regions.

(b). Anticipated reduction in assistance from Military Units in personnel, transport, plant and materials.

(c). Numerous densely populated Urban areas in the Northern Regions which increases the magnitude of Public Works problems and some of which may require the full time of one or more men. Furthermore many cities have more modern installations than at present encountered thus vastly increasing our difficulties with water and sewage problem.

2. We are unable at this time to furnish all of the names of officers who will be assigned to the Lombardia Region as we are still short of officers, in fact we have a requisition in for 23 more officers for this Sub-Commission to meet urgent demands.

4. As soon as additional officers are obtained we plan to assign two or more Public Works officers to your Region, as we feel all of the northerly Regions should be adequately staffed.
5. Insofar as the electrical work is concerned that is being operated on a national basis and rehabilitation is done by areas not by Regions. Our advance force which will ultimately be located at Milano is now at Florence and consists of Major Robert A. Bell (A), Capt. A. E. Duran (A), Capt. P. R. C. Stephens (B), and Capt. R. F. Lowdon (B).
6. These four officers will handle all of the electrical rehabilitation work in north Italy whereas Major Crowther who is assigned to your Region will take care of administration work regarding company management, distribution and rationing of electricity, cooperating closely with Maj. Bell and his men. If we get additional officers, we plan to assign several additional electrical officers to north Italy.

This Division of the Sub-Commission has since June 1943 operated on a completely de-centralized basis, with the bulk of the staff being assigned to regions and operating under the direct supervision of the Regional Engineers. The primary functions of Headquarters Personnel are:

(a) Contact with higher echelons of Military Organizations (b) establishing general policies and methods (c) financial approval of all military highways projects and of civilian projects in AOC territory (d) field inspection and general supervision of Regional Engineers (e) Technical approval of bridge plans and of construction methods (f) procurement and allocation of Officer personnel (g) General assistance in the procurement and distribution of materials and equipment.-

The Regional Officer Personnel are directly responsible for and in immediate supervision of all public works activities falling under our jurisdiction including Military Highways, Civil Highways in AMG territory, housing, public buildings, port reconstruction, etc. Liaison must be maintained with military Units in the field and their activities coordinated with ours and the Genio Civile. Activities in Regions within AMG territory require closer direction and supervision, therefore officer personnel in Italian Government territory has gradually been reduced in order to strengthen forward Regions.

Summarize:

(a) The Headquarters Staff is now at an absolute minimum for effective operation. Each officer is fully engaged in the functions outlined above-

(b) Regional Staffs. No reduction of officers can be effected on the above schedule if efficient operation is to be maintained. Several officers in each Region are fully engaged on Military Highway reconstruction and in certain Regions Public Works and Military Highways are not adequately supervised due to shortage of Officers. As the Northern Regions are activated the present officer strength will be entirely inadequate and assignments should be made now so that personnel can be trained. AMG 5th Army has requested the assignment of additional public works officers immediately, but at present this need cannot be met without the procurement of additional officers to the Sub-Commission.
