The undersigned, Gaetano ALOISI, Civil Engineer, requests the Allied Commission to engage him as an engineer.

He was born in Rome in 1889, obtained his degree in Civil engineering at the Royal School of Application for Engineers in Rome, in 1911.

After graduating he served in the Army in the Corps of Engineers.

His activity was as follows:

1913-1914: worked for the Enterprise "Saverio Parisi" for railroad constructions in Tuscany.

1915-1919: served in the Army as an Officer in the Corps of Engineers.

1920-1929: worked on his own account; projects, direction and execution of number of important works in various branches of civil engineering (bridges, roads, aqueducts, buildings, concrete constructions).

1930-1936: Engineer to the Government of Afghanistan. He projected and effectuated a number of works: bridges, roads, buildings, dams. All executed with great difficulties, owing to local conditions.

In 1934 he was sent by the Government of Afghanistan on mission to U.S.S.R. for the resolution of certain questions concerning the river Amu-Daria; visiting also Russian Turkestan and Tagikistan.

1939-1944: Director and promotor in Albania of an important Italian Constructions Enterprise ("Impresa Carnelli", Via XX Settembre, 5, Rome); he executed, as such, a number of important works.

In Albania he was arrested by the Germans, in Durazzo, on September 26, 1943, and kept as prisoner for over two months for having refused to obey the order to put the Enterprise presided by him at their disposition.

He left Albania in July 1944 and, travelling through Yugoslavia, Hungary and Northern Italy, returned to Rome.

He wishes to assume work commensurate with his qualifications and is ready to work also outside Rome, as his family is in Marche, near ~~Pesaro~~ ^{Pesaro}.

He does not speak English; he writes and speaks French fluently.

He never belonged to the Fascist Party.

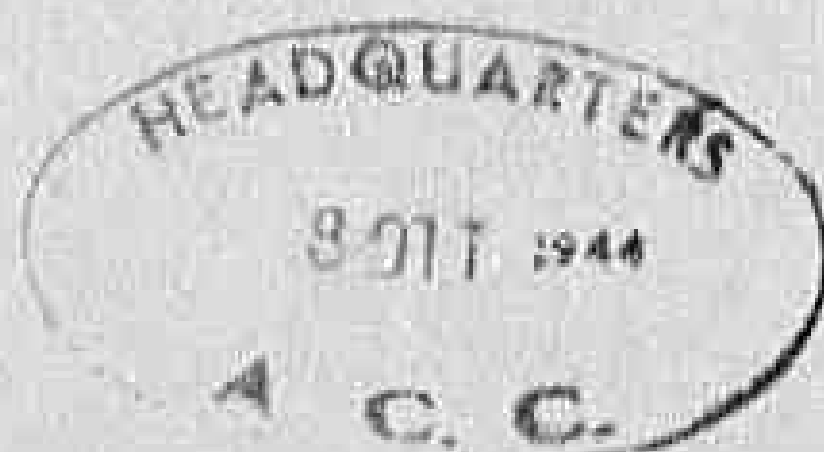

ING. GIACOMO GIOBBE - CURRICULUM VITAE -

Giacomo Giobbe was born in Rome, on the 28th of June; 1880. His father, dead in 1895, was one of the most renowned Architects of the town.

On the 31th of July, 1907, he took the degree as Civil Engineer, at the Scuola di Applicazione per gli Ingegneri, of Bologna, with the votation of 88/100. He entered the Royal Corps of Genio Civile; at Leghorn; where he was destined to the ports of the Island of Elba; and of the Tuscan Coast.

Leaving in 1910 the Genio Civile; he was taken in the studio of Architects Pio e Marcello Piacentini; in Rome, where, among other minor, he directed the works of Palazzo Madama, Palazzo Farnese Villa Pagnanelli etc.

In 1914 he was sent by Mr. Piacentini to North America to direct the works of the Italian Pavilion of the P.P. Exhibition at S. Francisco. He came back home on account of the war. He in 1916 was nominated officer of the Royal Engineer Corps and as lieutenant commander of the 14th company on the French front, near Verdun, St. Mihiel.

Having left the Army in March 1919 he was for a short time Assistant of Prof. Giovannoni in the Architectural School of Rome; then in the years 1920-1921 he made the executive project for the harbour of Ostia. In 1922 he entered the firm of construction Rattazzi and he built up the Palace in Via Viminale and the Supercinema, according his own project. In 1926-1927 he built three groups of cottages for the Istituto delle Case Popolari in Rome.

In 1928 he took part with several friends in the compilation of a new Piano Regolatore di Roma. In 1929-1929 he built a residence in Viale Liegi for the Impresa Letteri.

In 1931 he entered the Istituto Nazionale della Previdenza Sociale as director of works for the Sanatorium of Lucca, thence he was promoted Inspector for the thirteen hospitals in South Italy. In 1935 finally he was in Libya, always for the same Institute, where he remained till November 1938, building in Tripoli the Palace and Sanatorium and the village of Bir-Terrina.

From January to December 1940 he was in ALBANY (Tirana) building residences for the Imprese Letteri and Spallanzani.

In January 1943 he was employed in the Aeronautical Ministry whence he was dismissed in October 1943 on account of exuberance of personnel. He is especially fit for town regulation plan and architectural work (project and direction); is ready to go everywhere to his destination. He knows currently French and English languages.

SUBJECT: Assignment of Personnel.

TO : Regional Engineer, Piedmont Region.

1. In reviewing your plan of procedure for your new Region I note that you assign Major BUCKLEY to "Water Section" and Major EBERLE to "Roads, streets, public work".

2. I wish to call attention to the fact that we have found that the officer charged with the highway problems, particularly in a Region as large as yours, will be kept extremely busy on that vital problem alone, without taking on any other duties. Your organization in the Region must conform to the organizations in all other Regions. For this reason Major Buckley will be assigned the task of handling Water, Sewers, Buildings, Debris clearance and such general public works functions. Major Eberle will be assigned exclusively to the tasks of repairing and maintaining Highways and Bridges throughout the Region.

3. In any Region there may, from time to time, arise certain emergencies when it will be necessary for the Regional Engineer to request some of his Engineer Officers to handle special tasks. In that case you must naturally have the freedom of making such arrangements on a very temporary basis as you may find necessary to do from time to time.

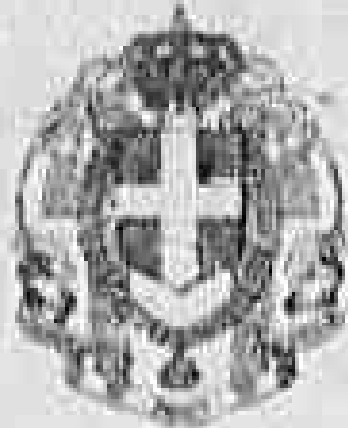

SUBJECT: Highway Construction Personnel.

1. Your letter of 25 May is referred.
2. In reply to the question of additional personnel wish to state as follows:-
- a) It must be obvious that when so much extra work is assigned to A.C.G. and so much extra equipment is to be requisitioned A.C.G. must have additional personnel.
- b) Before the request was made for additional personnel, the question of obtaining this technically trained personnel from military organizations on the mainland was discussed with the heads of these organizations and both the R.E. and P.E.S. Engineers stated that no such additional personnel was available. We endeavored for some time to obtain such personnel from Replacement Centers or other sources with only very scattering results. When men were received, they mostly had general engineering experience but were not the specialist type which we must have and which we have requested be sent here from the U. S. We stated that this personnel must come from the U. S. because we were also advised that such personnel was no longer available in Great Britain. We do know, however, that this personnel is available in the U. S.
- c) We also wish to make it clear that the additional personnel requested is not alone in connection with our military highway problems, but also meant for Public Works and Utilities problems and who must be 197 lists in these various fields. We have had to strengthen regional engineer organizations in recent weeks and now requests are being made at the present time to supply additional engineer officers for work in forward regions as the

arrive advance.

4) We wish to make it clear also that this personnel must be officer personnel as requested, as we cannot use civilians because we are constantly dealing with armed forces and with other military problems ahead. A civilian would look awfully like one other Italian and would not have proper authority. In addition, it would complicate travel and lodgings while in the field.

5. Insofar as the training of Italian personnel is concerned, we have very carefully studied this problem and have discussed it with the engineer officers of the various military units and we are all satisfied that Italian personnel can be trained by personnel of some of the military units but which units must shortly be prepared to move forward and they are extremely anxious for us to take over our added functions as quickly as possible.

6. We have been going on the theory that our request would be promptly honored at A.P.H.Q. and that the requested personnel had already been asked for in the U. S. We are in an extremely difficult position because of lack of personnel and we must stress the fact that it is imperative that this personnel be sent from the U. S. at the earliest possible moment or otherwise we will not be able to function.

7. The shipment of personnel over here must even precede the shipment of equipment as we must be organized to carry on the work with equipment temporarily furnished by the Armed Forces but which they must withdraw as soon as the equipment asked for arrives from the U. S.

8. It is requested, therefore, that immediate action be taken to expedite the sending of officers from the U. S. as requested and that the
