1. With the increased number of vehicles working on roads and other public works, including those recently loaned to us by the Army, it is deemed advisable to re-state the existing methods of keeping these vehicles supplied with P.O.L. and to make a suggestion for smoother functioning of the organization.

2. At the risk of repetition, and for the benefit of all P.W.S.U. Regional Officers recently appointed, the following is the present procedure:

- (a) The Regional Engineer Officer estimates the requirements of all his utilities and contractors, including the Genic Civile, on a monthly basis and submits the consolidated figures to his Regional Transport Officer.
- (b) The Regional Transport Officer, after consolidating with his other departments, submits the whole demand (on Pet Form No. 6) to Petroleum Section, AFHQ, on or before 15 of each month previous to consumption.
- (c) Petroleum Section, AFHQ, then notifies each region of the quantities that can be released for the coming month. The Rationing Authorities of A.C.C. then allot to civil consumers coupons to the amount permitted by the allocation made.
- (d) Physical distribution of P.O.L. is effected by C.I.P.

3. Obviously this system will only work if intelligent forecasts are made. If Regions run out of petrol before the end of the month it is due to either:

- (i) Underestimating.
- (ii) Unforeseen demands of an urgent nature which cannot be ignored.
- (iii) Issue of coupons to other users in excess of the supplies of petrol allocated. Normally trucks when granted circulating permits receive coupons to cover 150 litres for a month.

4. The following suggestions are made, more especially for those Regions who are just opening up with extensive programmes of work.

Give your Regional Transport Officer an idea of approximately how many contractors you expect to employ and the number of their vehicles, if any, so that he may know what to expect when you ask for circulation passes. The contractor, owning a vehicle, must be given a letter before a circulation pass will be issued.

State, if you can, for how long the pass should be valid, to prevent misuse after completion of the contract.

Normally, as stated in paragraph 3 (iii), when these passes are issued, the recipient gets coupons for 150 litres.

In most cases, this is entirely inadequate for our contractors and it is therefore necessary to state in the letter of request for circulation pass that the contractor must be supplied with sufficient petrol for his essential needs, say up to 800 litres per truck per month.

5. Discussion with Petroleum Section of the above system has resulted in the following suggestion.

(a) That the Regional Engineer arrange with the rationing Control Officer for issue to him in bulk coupons to the value of the quantity of petrol allocated against his demand by Petroleum Section. The fact must be stressed that this work is of a high military character and that, therefore, adequate provision must be made.

(b) That the Regional Engineer, having first hand knowledge of the actual requirements of each vehicle working for him, issue coupons accordingly each week, or as he may decide.

6. By this means, as jobs are finished, petrol will be saved, and these savings will provide an emergency pool in the hands of the Regional Engineer, to take care of any jobs unforeseen at the time of the monthly forecast.

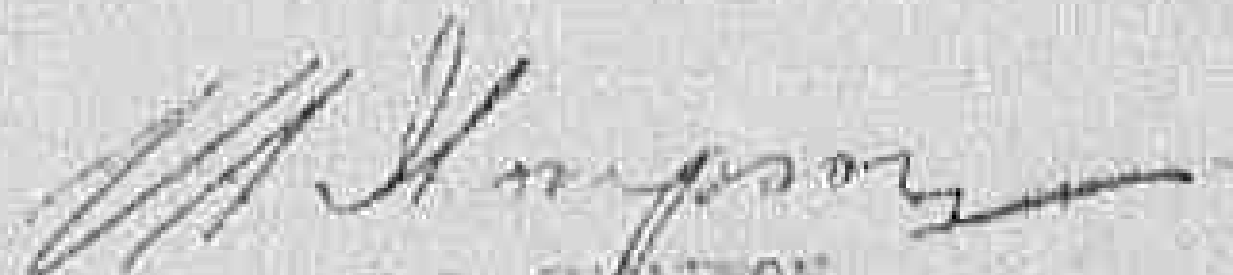
7. Contractors will be placed in the position of having to justify their requirements, a situation which unfortunately does not always hold at present.

8. Finally the FGL picture in regard to the Army vehicles on loan for military highway construction. AFHQ has ruled that these vehicles cannot draw from Army petrol points unless they are employed directly by the Allied Forces.

It is therefore necessary for the Regional Engineer to include these vehicles in his monthly total.

A suggested figure, approved by Petroleum Section, AFHQ, is 800 litres per truck per month, if operated 26 days a month.

It is essential that the number of trucks operating be shown when estimating, stating number running on petrol and number on diesel oil.

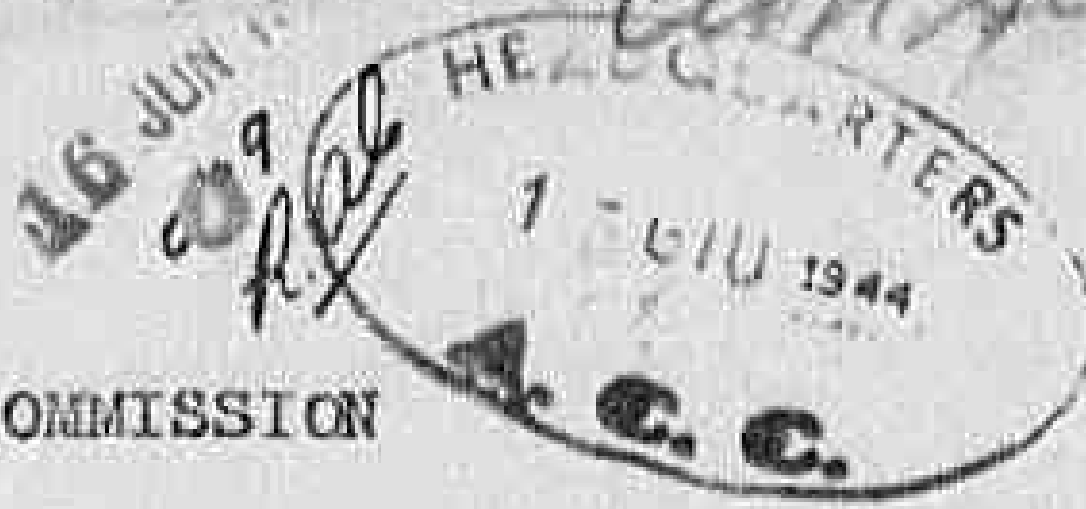

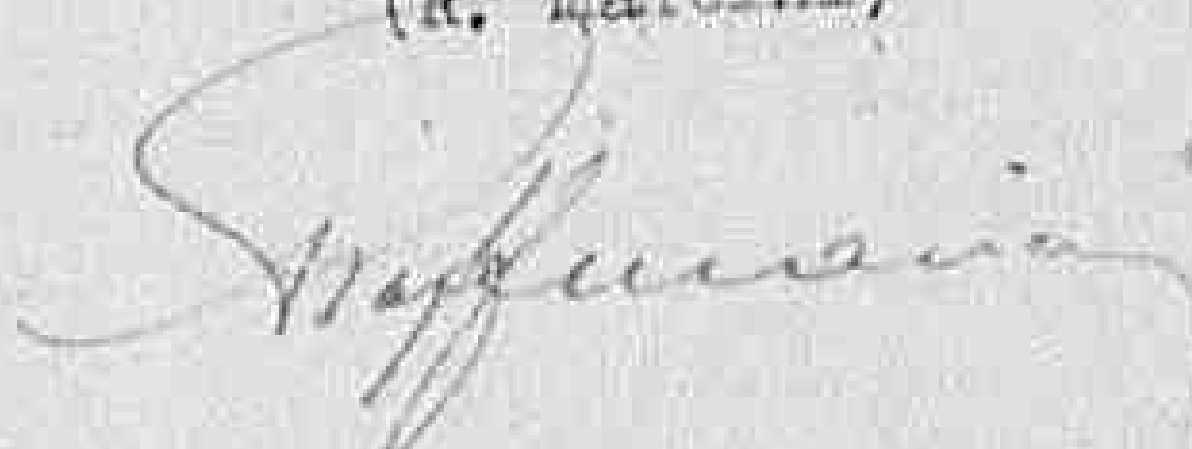

1. The situation in respect to R.A.S.C. supplies for A.C.C. projects is very unsatisfactory.
2. Under the present system, contractors requiring fuel and lubricants are supplied from:
 - (a) Civilian sources, on the regular ration card system (Petrol and Oil).
 - (b) On demand from R.A.S.C. sources.
 - (c) On demand from R.E. sources.
3. As no allotment of fuel and lubricants has been made to A.C.C., demands from civilian contractors necessitate their satisfaction from stocks against which commitments have been made.
4. Supplies are always obtainable, however, and the present "set up" means that they have to be "scrounged" from one or other of the agencies who possess them. This is both costly in time and not at all necessary if arrangements are made for:
 - (a) Allotments of fuel and lubricants from R.A.S.C. sources.
 - (b) Authority for issue of petrol coupons by the local A.C.C. Roads Officer, direct to the contractor or other civilian person or agency, i.e. civilian road engineers etc., without application or reference to A.M.C.
5. Inasmuch as many of the contractors appear to be improvident and indifferent, and without any idea of organisation, instances have occurred where supplies have been entirely exhausted before

- 2 -

application for more was made, with the resultant delay of going through "channels" for further supplies.

6. It is strongly recommended that the suggestions set forth in Para. 4 (a) and (b) above be put into effect immediately. For the next six weeks (to 1 May) the following is a rough estimate of A.C.C. requirements for civilian contractors, per week :

Diesel Fuel Oil.	-	7000 litres per week.
Lubricating Oil.	-	400 " " "

1. The situation in respect to R.A.S.C. supplies for A.C.C. projects is very unsatisfactory.
2. Under the present system, contractors requiring fuel and lubricants are supplied from:
 - (a) Civilian sources, on the regular ration card system (Petrol and Oil).
 - (b) On demand from R.A.S.C. sources.
 - (c) On demand from R.E. sources.
3. As no allotment of fuel and lubricants has been made to A.C.C., demands from civilian contractors necessitate their satisfaction against which commitments have been made.
4. Supplies are always obtainable, however, and the present "set u means that they have to be "acronged" from one or other of the agencies who possess them. This is both costly in time and not at all necessary if arrangements are made for:
 - (a) Allotments of fuel and lubricants from R.A.S.C. sources.
 - (b) Authority for issue of petrol coupons by the local A.C.C. Roads Officer, direct to the contractor or other civilian person or agency, i.e. civilian road engineers etc., without application or reference to A.M.G.
5. Inasmuch as many of the contractors appear to be improvident and indifferent, and without any idea of organia 3302 instances have occurred where supplies have been entirely exhausted before application for more was made, with the resultant delay of going through "channels" for further supplies.
