Dear Brig. Lush,

Your D/O of 6th July on the Risorgimento article on my views on the Naples Flyover proposal. The Risorgimento published an accurate translation of the interview, and I attach for your information my English copy from which the translation was made.

You will see a history of this in my G/1749 of 11th December 1945. I have an affection for Naples, and should hate to see its natural beauty spoilt, and it became necessary to clarify the position as A.N.C. had become connected with this absurd and somewhat discreditable scheme put up by Mr. Townsend, which had caused a good deal of indignation.

Mr. Townsend was an E.N.A. employee sent to us in Naples as our official Public Utilities officer, and apparently spent part of his time working on this project which I can only presume would have been for his personal enrichment. He launched the good news to the Naples Press when I was away on leave, and the whole thing was hatched without my knowing anything about it. If the Italians want a flyover they can build it, but at least don't let us have A.N.C. or the Allied Commission mixed up in it.

Notes on Mr. H. H. Townsend.

Mr. Townsend was a civilian F.E.A. employee sent to Naples to be Public Water and Utilities officer.

He is a middle aged ^{slender} American citizen, no real engineering knowledge or background, but a "go getter" and full of energy. He did a good job of work but was very unorthodox in his methods.

After he left A.M.G. and F.E.A. at the end of 1945 he continued to wear American officers uniform, without badges or name, and live in the Excelsior Hotel Naples. Eventually P.B.S. had to close up a notice that warned him (he was usually known as Colonel Townsend) that he would be arrested if seen again in U.S. uniform. Since then I have seen him in plain clothes only.

The San Lucia project was apparently for his own enrichment and I have been at some pains to ^{also} make my disapproval of such a project being put up by him in ~~his~~ ^{his} government as A.M.G. officer.

TRANSLATIONTHE QUESTION OF THE SKYSCRAPER
What Colonel Pennycuik thinks

The readers will remember that towards the end of 1945 there was some talk about an American project for the construction of a building on the waterfront of S. Lucia. The "skyscraper", as it was generally called, should have been built between the Molosiglio and via Nazario Sauro, exactly in front of via Cesareo Console.

Various months have passed since then: the most absolute silence on the matter made people believe that the project had been given up. Instead, it has come up again in these days and it seems even that its realization is quite imminent.

The day before yesterday we have published a vote expressed by the Neapolitan Committee of the Association for the restoration of war-damaged monuments; yesterday Col J.A.C. Pennycuik expressed his thought as follows:

THE PROJECT. - I heard for the first time the news about a skyscraper to be built at Santa Lucia in December 1948 upon my return from a leave in England. I was highly surprised when this project already developed in all its details was submitted to me. Briefly, the project consisted of a 20 floors-building to be built on the waterfront at Santa Lucia. The foundations of this building were to reach about 30 meters under the sea level where they were supposed to find some rocks. From the technical point of view, the idea seemed interesting as a central pillar or tower was planned, from which were to branch out the upper floors in a way presupposing an enormous force and complicated steel structures.

This unique building was going to accommodate maritime offices, restaurants, hotels, a Casino with gambling rooms etc. At the base of the tower was also to be organized a space to enable hydroplanes to take off. The advantages were the following: employment of workers for the construction; an attraction for the tourists in Naples.

I studied carefully the project and reached the conclusion that, as far as the employment of workers was concerned, the special structure of the construction would require an enormous work in a steel of special fabrication which ought to be imported from abroad. Certainly, there would have been jobs for some Italians, but the quantity of these could not be considerable as they could be occupied only in a limited space.

As to the second point - the attraction for tourists - only the future can decide about that, but if the aesthetic qualities of Naples will be spoiled by a building in contrast with the general outline of the place and with the traditions of its gulf, it may also happen that instead of attracting tourists it would induce them to avoid the city.

THE OPINION OF A.C. - Therefore, I gave clearly to understand that I did not approve the scheme and I told the Mayor as well as the Prefect in a conference that it was not in any way encouraged by the Allied Commission and that personally I fully disapproved it. I also repeated this to our Ross Headquarters. It seems however that the civilian authorities have given their approval in a very vague form foreseeing a possibility of employment and therefore it may still happen that the plan is carried out. It seems anyways that it is being discussed again judging from the press notices which appeared in the last days.

I want first of all repeat clearly that this is your town and it is you who have to live here. We are here only temporarily and the question must be solved by you only. I had the privilege to live in Naples a year and everybody knows that this is one of the most beautiful bays in the world. Therefore, allow me that as an engineer I call your attention to a few aspects of the project so that you may take them into consideration:

There is an English saying that while the doctors bury their mistakes, the engineers and architects put them in evidence so that they become a "jinx" for the coming generations. You have in Naples a partially destroyed waterfront placed in a splendid frame. This is a precious opportunity to rebuild a dignified and attractive city which will draw to its shores people who will exclaim with joy as soon as they see it for the first time.

In the past, Italian architects earned a great fame in the whole world. It will be sufficient to cite the case of Emperor Shah Jahan who had the Taj Mahal built on the shore of the river Jumna 300 years ago. This building is considered the most beautiful in the world and was planned by an Italian architect, the artist Geronimo Verroneo. If you achieved so much in the past, you can also now give a new example to the world in the reconstruction of Naples. Your civilian authorities wish that the population may express its opinion about this skyscraper project and you can certainly do so. But whatever this opinion will be, whether for or against the project, I want it to be clear to everybody that it has never been encouraged by this office. Personally I would be happy to see you all at work for the reconstruction of your city according to a new regulating plan, with your materials and your architects. There has been recently an Exhibition which had an extensive success with regard to this regulating plan of yours and it would give me a great satisfaction if I could do something which could be of any assistance for the rebirth of Naples.

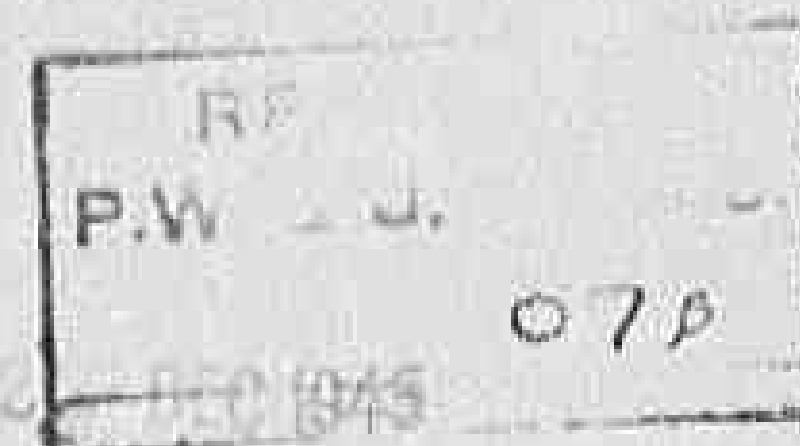

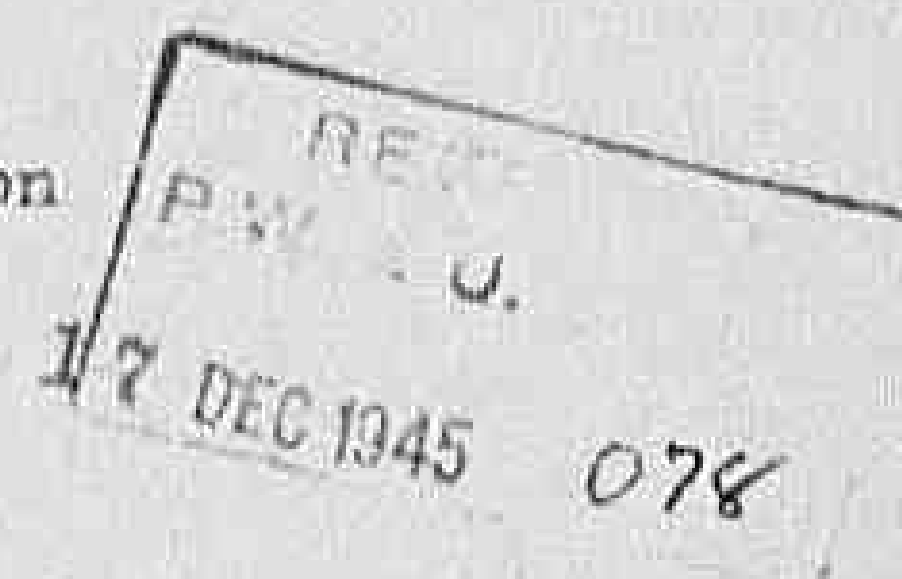

SUBJECT : Rebuilding of Naples.

CH

1. As a result of our operations in Italy, the City of Naples suffered considerable damage, not only from Allied bombs but also from deliberate demolitions carried out by the Germans.
2. The result of this has not been wholly a disadvantage, as some very poor parts of Naples, slum areas, sprawling dock areas and ugly commercial buildings have been destroyed. As a result there is an opportunity for a planned rebuilding scheme on a dignified and comprehensive scale.
3. Naples has been endowed by nature with a setting of exceptional beauty. Italian architects and engineers have gained world wide renown and I regard it as of great importance, even National importance, that a reconstruction scheme should be properly carried out. I am not at all in favour of plans to construct ~~great~~ ^{great} buildings of unduly vast dimensions, with foreign capitals.
4. The stages I consider the project should follow are:
 - (a) Planning stage;
 - (b) The commencement of reconstruction of types of buildings agreed at the planning;
 - (c) General reconstruction controlled by a master plan, and financed by a loan which the Municipality should float. Rents should be sufficiently assured and certain to make such a loan attractive even to foreign capital.
5. With this end in view the planning has been started under the auspices of the Sindaco and very promising proposals have been evolved. They include:

4473

- (a) - More space for the docks and shipping, to be achieved by a main road or boulevard running round the dock area. This is essential if we are to allow for increase of trade and prosperity which it is hoped Naples will see. The attached plan illustrates this part of the new proposals, but represents only one tentative alternative, there are other solutions. This area, however, should be the first to be dealt with as bomb damage here is particularly heavy.
- (b) - A move of the goods station further to the North East, so as to free a large and valuable area now occupied by sidings etc. for the building of workers' flats and houses.
- (c) - A move "out" of some of the industrial plants, in the much bombed area South of the Station, for the same purpose. The new industrial area to be connected by rail and canal to the port.
- (d) - The development of more through roads in the city some by an ingenious resort to tunnelling so as to avoid damage to ancient buildings of interest.
- (e) - The development of a flying boat anchorage for large flying boats at the sheltered bay at Pozzuoli and the development of the Capodichino airport.

6. There is a certain amount of prejudice to be overcome and great conservatism with regard to ancient edifices. Another tendency is a demand for the hasty rebuilding of tenements in the quickest possible method on existing sites. Such a procedure would, however, perpetuate bad features of accommodation and throw away a wonderful opportunity to reconstruct the town on sound lines.

7. To arouse local interest and make the plans known it is hoped to organize an exhibition for the public to visit. In the meantime the Press has come out with references to a proposal to build a monster 20 storey edifice on reclaimed land on the water front near Santa Lucia. This particular project was developed without my knowledge and there appears to be some irresponsibility in the Office of the Genio Civile. I was shown the plan of this very doubtful commercial venture for the first time on the 11th of December by Mr. Townsend, and write this letter to inform you of the main rebuilding project.

8. I recommend that the considered rebuilding plan I have outlined above should be brought to the notice of the Italian Government, in particular the Ministry of Works, and they should be asked to give it their immediate earnest attention. Such planned rebuilding will also have the advantage of giving widespread employment and in my opinion, be of far greater benefit to the City than any sensational 20 storey tower even if the foundations for such a structure should prove commercially sound and practicable on the chosen site.

1. Reference to the report of the Liaison Officer regarding conditions on the islands of Pantelleria and Lampedusa, the following is the status: these islands are A.M.G. territory but attached to the provinces of Trapani and Agrigento respectively for administrative purpose. The prefects of these provinces have allowed only small amounts of money for rehabilitation and reconstruction on the islands with the result that too little has been accomplished during the period since becoming A.M.G. territory.

Having A.M.G. territory administered under Italian Government authority is exactly the reverse of normal practice and this has hampered the allocation of funds necessary for proper public works operations.

2. Arrangements have now been made with the Finance Sub-Commission to allocate funds for public works on these islands upon approval of projects on Form AG-1 in the normal procedure, namely the Genio Civile will submit their estimates thru the liaison officer to the Public Works and Utilities Dept. A.C. for approval and funds for approved projects will then be allocated thru the Finance Sub-Commission.
