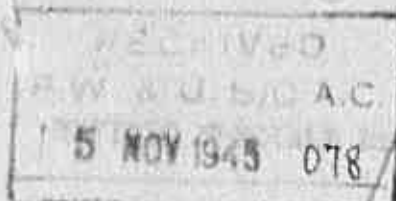

1. I regret to inform you that Penbase can be of no assistance to you in the removal of mines from the vicinity of the Tomba Torrent at Km 376+500, Route #1, Via Aurelia as they no longer have available any specialists in this line of work.

2. I am informed, however, that there are several firms of Italian civilians who specialize in mine clearance and who would be pleased to undertake this work for you.

3. I am of the opinion that the cost of mine clearance is a legitimate project expenditure.
