SUBJECT: Asphalt release.

TO : Regional Engineer, Lombardia.

1. Reference your PWU/6.1 of 21 August 1945.
2. On July 29 the undersigned personally took the release in favor of AMG 5 Army from 5th Army engineer for all asphalt at Caldonazzo to the Caldonazzo dump together with a copy of the release for the 125 tons for your region signed by him.
3. No Italian guard officer could be found so the papers were left with the Italian guard on duty with full instructions to honor the green releases signed by the undersigned as the 5th Army release covered the entire stock and it was desired to distribute it among several different regions. The guard apparently understood and either failed to properly explain it to his officer or his officer has taken an arbitrary stand.
4. On the same date the undersigned counted the barrels on hand and on the basis of that count estimated a stock of 425 tons of asphalt on hand in the dump instead of 7200 tons as shown on inventory.
5. On the 30th releases for a total of 300 tons were issued to Liguria, Emilia and Piemonte Regions as the release for 125 tons had been mailed to you on July 28.
6. Obviously withdrawals are exceeding releases not only in Caldonazzo but in Monzambano. However there are no other stocks of asphalt available to this headquarters. In Monzambano, releases were issued on the basis of the quantity stated as being on hand at the time by the Engineer Supply Officer, 5th Army.
