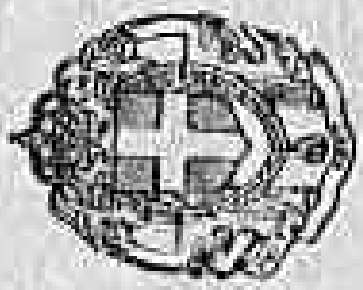

Subject: Finance in AMG Territory of War damage repairs.

To : Regional Engineer, Toscana Region.

1. Reference your RVIII/PWU/4/1 of 15 October 44.
2. I am familiar with the financial circular referred to and consider that it is a step towards clarifying an hitherto indefinite procedure.
3. Your criticisms however are sound and will be dealt with.
4. I consider that para 3(a) authorizing expenditures up to L. 200,000 with-out reference to you is a step in relaxing some of our control and as such is to be expected and welcomed. Furthermore, such small projects will be so numerous that there is a danger that either necessary work would be delayed or that the Regional Engineer would be incapable of dealing with them all effectively. We should not object to this, provided that no critical materials are used and finances are authorized in the proper manner.
5. You will see in our own directive that in Italian Government Territory such a concession has been granted up to L.500,00, and the Regional Engineer is informed by means of monthly reports.
6. Para. 3(b) and 3(c) conform to our own instructions.
7. The question of Private Property is of great political significance and as explained will eventually come under the scheme at present being worked out for Italian Government Territory.

Consequently it is essential that no preferential treatment be accorded such projects in AMC Territory which might cause hardship on the subsequent hand over. It is for this reason that emergency schemes must be approved for financing at this level. Minor damage is covered by the procedure outlined in Para. 5.

SUBJECT: War Damage
TO : All Regional Finance Officers.

1. The problem of the financing of the work of repair, replacement or reconstruction of war damaged property has lately been under consideration and the policy adopted for AMG territory is stated in the following paragraphs.

2. War Damaged is divided into that involving:-
- (a) Public property (including industrial property of primary importance).
 - (b) Private property (including housing);
 - (c) Minor damage to private houses and institutions.
 - (d) Personal Chattels (e.g. clothing, furniture, domestic utensils).

3. PUBLIC PROPERTY

An appropriation has been made in the Italian State budget to cover all expenditures on public works arising from war damage. An allotment of this appropriation has been given to each province where works are contemplated. Expenditures will only be authorized when estimates of work projects have been approved by the Public Works & Utilities Sub-Commission, HQ. ACC.

In AMG territory, credits will only be authorized for public works arising from war damage in the following circumstances:-

- (a) Projects, not involving the use of critical materials and not exceeding 200,000 lire in estimated cost, approved by the Genio Civile, and for which budget estimates on forms G.B. have been approved by the Intendente di Finanza and the Provincial Finance Officer;
- (b) Projects, not involving the use of critical materials, exceeding 200,000 but not 1,000,000 lire must, in ad-

1. The problems of the financing of the work of repair, replacement or reconstruction of war damaged property has lately been under consideration and the policy adopted for AMG territory is stated in the following paragraphs.

2. War Damaged is divided into that involving:-

- (a) Public property (including industrial property of primary importance).
- (b) Private property (including housing);
- (c) Minor damage to private houses and institutions.
- (d) Personal Chattels (e.g. clothing, furniture, domestic utensils).

3. PUBLIC PROPERTY

An appropriation has been made in the Italian State budget to cover all expenditures on public works arising from war damage. An allotment of this appropriation has been given to each province where works are contemplated. Expenditures will only be authorised when estimates of work projects have been approved by the Public Works & Utilities Sub-Commission, HQ. ACG.

In AMG territory, credits will only be authorised for public works arising from war damage in the following circumstances:-

- (a) Projects, not involving the use of critical materials and not exceeding 200.000.lire in estimated cost, approved by the Genio Civile, and for which budget estimates on forms S.P. have been approved by the Intendente di Finanza and the Provincial Finance Officer;
- (b) Projects, not involving the use of critical materials, exceeding 200.000 but not 1.000.000.lire must, in addition be approved by the Regional Engineer Officer.
- (c) Projects exceeding 1.000.000 lire in estimated cost must be approved by the Public Works & Utilities Sub-Commission, HQ. ACG.

4. PRIVATE PROPERTY

In Italian Government Territory a comprehensive scheme is to be introduced to provide for the repair or reconstruction of war damaged private dwellings. The scheme will not apply to territory under Allied Military Government at present but it will be extended to such territory as soon as it is transferred to the jurisdiction of the Italian Government. No authorization of credit should therefore be made by AMG Finance Officers in the field, to provide for any general scheme of repair or reconstruction of private houses or public institutions. If any such scheme is deemed to be necessary in order to provide a mere subsistence level to the civilian population, it will be made the subject of works project, and approved as stated in paragraph 3 (c).

5. MINOR DAMAGE TO PRIVATE HOUSES OR PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS

(i) Two classes of persons are involved:-

(a) Those who may prefer a claim against the Italian Government (under RDL 26 Oct. 1940, n. 1543).

(b) Those who are excluded from the provisions of RDL 26 Oct. 1940, n. 1543.

(ii) Persons who have a legal claim against the Italian Government must present their claim in writing to the Intendente di Finanza as provided in Art. 13 of RDL 26 Oct. 1940, n. 1543, using the approved Italian Government form of claim. The Intendente will be empowered to approve claims up to L. 10.000 provided he is satisfied, and certifies as to the bona-fides of each claim; that materials for the work are available locally and that no critical materials are involved.

(iii) Person who have no legal claim may make a claim to the Sindaco, using the Italian Government form of claim. The Sindaco will be required to certify each claim in the same manner as is required of the Intendente (see para 5 (ii) above).

(iv) A credit will be established by the Provincial Finance Officer under capitolo 89 in the budget of the Genio Civile, for "minor repairs or replacements of war damaged property".

If any such scheme is deemed to be necessary in order to provide a mere subsistence level to the civilian population, it will be made the subject of works project, and approved as stated in paragraph 3 (c).

MINOR DAMAGE TO PRIVATE HOUSES OR PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS

(i) Two classes of persons are involved:-

(a) Those who may prefer a claim against the Italian Government (under RDL 26 Oct. 1940, n. 1543).

(b) Those who are excluded from the provisions of RDL 26 Oct. 1940, n. 1543.

(ii) Persons who have a legal claim against the Italian Government must present their claim in writing to the Intendente di Finanza as provided in Art. 13 of RDL 26 Oct. 1940, n. 1543, using the approved Italian Government form of claim. The Intendente will be empowered to approve claims up to L. 10.000 provided he is satisfied, and certifies as to the bona-fides of each claim; that materials for the work are available locally and that no critical materials are involved.

(iii) Person who have no legal claim may make a claim to the Sindaco, using the Italian Government form of claim. The Sindaco will be required to certify each claim in the same manner as is required of the Intendente (see para 5 (ii) above).

(iv) A credit will be established by the Provincial Finance Officer under capitolo 89 in the budget of the Genio Civile, for "minor repairs or replacements of war damaged property".

(v) The claims certified by the Sindaco will be sent to the Intendente to authorize payment against the credit established in para 5 (iv).

(vi) The Intendente di Finanza will furnish to the Provincial Finance Officer at the end of each month an account of claims authorized and of payments made.

6. CLAIMS FOR PERSONAL CHATTELS lost or damaged by war action will be dealt with similarly. As, however, little or no replacements can be purchased locally, no payments should be authorized unless clothing, ect. is known to be available. The Intendente (or Sindaco) should certify on the claims that the claimant has suffered the loss of the articles claimed.

7. BUDGET ESTIMATES

Expenditure for any work of repair, replacement or reconstruction of war damaged property is chargeable only to the budget of the Ministry of Public Works (Genio Civile). No expenditures for such work may therefore appear in the budgets of communes or provinces.

EXTRACT from Situation Report 10 Corps Area to 20 Sept 44.4. PUBLIC UTILITIES.

In BIBBIENA the water supply commenced to fail and two water carts were obtained from Corps. It has not been possible to reach the source of supply and clear the choke, as it is in enemy hands. A sufficient supply is being maintained.

In SUBBIANO and CAPOLONA the water mains have been repaired and the supply is adequate. Electricity is not available, but the mills are meeting requirements. The water system of PIOMBICO is under repair, but sufficient water is available from other sources. Electric power (water generated) is available and will be connected to APECCHIO in a few days. In the latter town the water system is undamaged and the water good. In S. ANGELO IN VADO work has commenced upon repairs to the piped water supply. Meanwhile, sufficient water is being carried to houses. Work has commenced on repair of road bridges over the R. Metauro and on local roads.

In SANSEPOLCRO the water pipe line has been repaired and work on sewage continues satisfactorily. Repair on the local hospital is in hand, also repairs to the bridge leading to S. GIUSTINO.

The Corps Commander expressed the opinion to the L.O. that less work on roads and bridges appeared to be undertaken by civilians in AREZZO Province than had been the case in other Provinces. The matter has been discussed with the P.C. AREZZO Province, who states that the Genio Civile has a programme in preparation.

7. AGRICULTURE & HARVESTING

Good progress has been made with the threshing of grain during the week. In BIBBIENA, sequestered German petrol has been used, but some supply of POL will be necessary to complete the work.

In SUBBIANO, CAPOLONA area about 50% of the grain has been threshed and agricultural conditions are approaching normal.

In the Communes of S. ANGELO IN VADO, PIOBBICO and APECCHIO threshing has commenced, but POL is urgently required. Steam and other means are being used as far as possible. U.P.S.E.A. Committees have been formed in these Communes, in which the crop is good and has been carted in to farms. Thirteen water mills are available in APECCHIO and one water electric mill at PIOBBICO.

U.P.S.E.A. for PIEVE S. STEFANO will be operated from SANSEPOLCRO for the time being. The electric mill is working in SANSEPOLCRO.

I- Reference your letter ACC/099/PWU dated 6 Jul 44, addressed to all Regional Engineers, on P.O.L. Supply and Distribution, the following points are raised, and your instructions would be appreciated.

- a) Regional Supply Officer informs me that Pet. Form N.6 is submitted to Petroleum Section, A.C.C. by the Regional Supply Officers (ie. not Regional Transport Officer?) and when possible through Provincial Supply Officers. Under a directive issued by Petroleum Section A.C.C. on 4 Aug 44 (which was brought to my notice by chance to-day) demands must be forwarded by the Regional Supply Officer to reach Rome by 10th of each month for submission to A.F.H.Q. by 15th of each month.
- "Every endeavour will be made" to publish the allocations by 20th of each month, showing the quantities released for the following month. It was pointed out that quantities must be based on the actual consumption of the cars used on specified duties and registered as such, also that the quantity is invariably cut-down, and that a release does not guarantee that the fuel can be supplied.
- Can you confirm that this is the case please?

- b) In so far as Region VIII is concerned, the Province of Grosseto was handed over to Regional control during the last week, and in consequence of the order mentioned above my demands for P.O.L. for September cannot be accepted as they are too late

- c) It is increasingly apparent that further provinces will be handed over to Regional Control in the very near future, and from advance information received it is anticipated that the amount of work to be done during the next three months will be very considerable.
- d) The Army do not arrange to cover the transition period between the handing-over date and the date upon which P.O.L. can be obtained under the arrangement set out in (a) above. *Police already here* and although L-of G. Engineers would probably arrange for military contracts they do not cover civilian needs however high in priority. Evidence of this was given by the action of Fifth Army and P.B.S. in connection with the bridge contract in Grosseto Province.
- e) In view of this can steps be taken to provide " transitional cover " for P.O.L. supplies until such time as the official machinery can be brought into action. If necessary the issues could be made against subsequent returns to show how it had been expended. It is obviously impossible to estimate future requirements on the basis laid down in (a) above when firstly the area of operations is not known six weeks ahead, and equally the number of vehicles cannot be ascertained prior to entering into the contracts or even the area itself.

Subject: Region VIII - Roads and Bridges.

To : Chief, Public Wks. Div. PW&U. S/C.

Noted 29/7

Route 1. - Region Boundary Northward to Albegna Bridge - Surface now in fair condition but beginning to wear through. Edges bad in sections. No evidence of maintenance either by Cantonieri or contractor.--

Bridge. - Albegna River - Diversion satisfactory at present. Probably could not stand flood water. Contract awarded to Soc. Generale Immobiliare and few workmen are on job. Compressor and certain other miscellaneous equipment on ground and clean up and preparation for reconstruction now under way.--

Route 74 . + From Route 1 Eastward to Regional Boundary. Road has at one time been surfaced with bitumen but has very little surface remaining. Occasional Cantoniere at work using whatever material is at hand to dress macadam surface.-- Traffic is very light and situation can be controlled by addition of a number of Cantonieri.-- Road can be brought to standards of other main highways only by major reconstruction, which traffic does not warrant.--

Bridges: (1) Over Canal Approx. 3 Km. East of Albegna - Five span concrete deck structure blown but by-pass adequate. No action has been requested by Military Authorities.

(2) Manciano Bridge.-- 8 Km. East of Manciano - Stone masonry arch structure. Two central arches (Apprx. 40' each) are blown. Central pier appears to be undamaged. East pier is undamaged but does not appear to require more than minor repair. Diversion is good (not too steep) but difficulty would probably be encountered with seasonal flood waters. Contractor Soc. Generale Immobiliare has been told to start work but no signs of activity on job.

Pitigliano Bridge: Stone masonry arch reconstruction of major nature. Bridge is over Gorge immediately West of town. Diversion is long and grades are difficult for heavy loads. No signs of great volume of water so probably diversion would stand.

Five of the seven spans are blown. - Spans average 45' and reach a maximum height of 60' -
Remaining two spans appear to be undamaged. Piers ^{appear} to be in fair condition but would require some investigation -
This job has been laid on to Soc. Generale Immobiliare who is to begin work immediately. - NO signs of activity on job. at time of inspection.
