I shall be glad if in the light of the following information you can kindly make as many forward arrangements as possible to enable work to continue immediately a decision is arrived at. I attach a list of jobs in your area (1.1.1. from River Bridge, A.F. A. 0.704 to 001. 0.704) which I consider essential in their order of priority. It is imperative that these be completed before the heavy rains commence in order to keep open to traffic all weather conditions. The list is by no means complete but represents only the more essential work. ~~Complete list of all work to be completed will be provided to you at a later date.~~

3. In accordance with our conversation will you, therefore, please obtain plans for the former two and evaluate as suggested for the A.F. 1.1.1. and make tentative arrangements for reconstruction by your various contractors who should, during the above mentioned period, examine the sites and furnish you with estimates. Contractors should, at the same time, if any of the nature of labor and quantity of cement required for each, be stating what quantities, if any, they themselves can supply or obtain through the A.F. 1.1.1. On receipt of this information from you I will endeavor to obtain, through my sources, any stores and plants which contractors cannot obtain from civil sources. I cannot, however, supply contractors with either fuel, food or fuel etc. for their use but these can possibly be arranged for them by A.F. 1.1.1. direct with higher authorities.
