1. A request has just been received from the Regional Engineer, Venezia Region for assistance in obtaining the allocation of 7 new passenger vehicles from the Fiat factory for sale to the Ministry of Public Works for use by Genio Civile Venezia.

2. The need for these vehicles is extremely urgent as work in Venezia cannot be properly organized and supervised due to inadequate transport.

3. Will you please investigate and advise this Headquarters of the possibility of obtaining a release of vehicles for the purpose outlined above.

3. In the event of these vehicles forthcoming, they would be split up according to requirements at the following towns: Verona - Padova - Treviso - Rovigo - Trento - Bolzano.
4. The Capb's Compartimentos have been consulted and are willing to operate the vehicles which may be handed over to them.

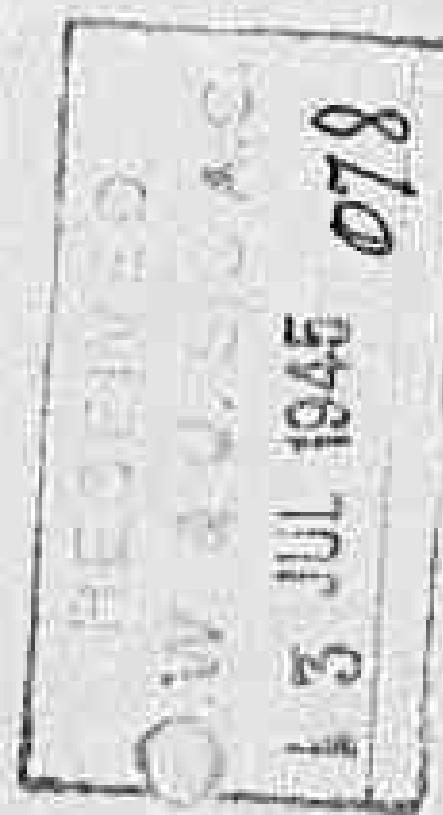
1. We are advised that any vehicles available from the Fiat factory are under the control of Regional Transportation Officer, Lombardia Region and releases are not effected at this Headquarters.

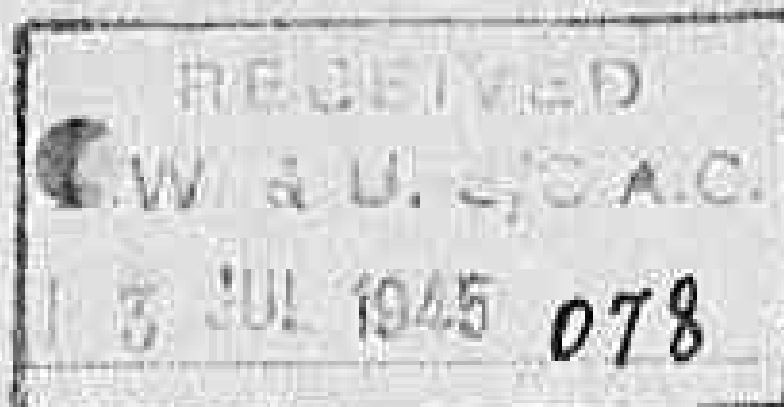

1. It is understood that there are large number of surplus army vehicles (allied and German) in 5th Army. If this the case, it is asked if these might be obtained for the use of the U.S.V.S. (late A.A.S.S.) and Genio Civile, of the Italian Ministry of Public Works.

2. This Division is initiating urgent works on highways, bridges and public works generally at the request of the Military Authorities.

3. These works are being executed by the U.S.V.S. and Genio Civile or contractors working under them.

4. At present certain materials and all transport are being supplied by the Army, due to the fact that the U.S.V.S. and Genio Civile have no transport of their own; neither have their contractors.

5. When the time comes for the Army to pull out, a serious situation will arise due to the non-availability of motor transport and the programme laid down by the Military will be in danger of coming to a standstill.

6. It is asked therefore, if you can make representations to the Military Authorities, to obtain a release of any surplus Army vehicles, for the use of the U.S.V.S. and Genio Civile to enable them to carry out the work required of them by the Military Authorities.

7. The area to be covered is extensive and in some parts very mountainous and it is estimated that at least 150 trucks (including any "dump trucks" that might be available) will be required to maintain the routes the Military Authorities have given this Division to maintain, and also for the execution of public works which have to be done by the Genio Civile.

8. It is also asked if 10 or 12 passenger vehicles might be made available for use of the Italian Engineers, to enable them to

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8. It is also asked if 10 or 12 passenger vehicles might be made available for use of the Italian Engineers, to enable them to carry out their duties and inspections.
9. Account has to be made for the fact that the vehicles will undoubtedly be those that have already seen much service and therefore an allowance has to be made for a percentage to be always off the road under repair.
10. Another point is, that if these vehicles can be made available it is necessary that tools be supplied with them and sufficient spare tyres, also the availability of spares to effect any necessary mechanical repairs.

11. Should there be amongst any captured German vehicles which have been seized any snow ploughs, it is asked if 15 of these may be handed over to the U.S.V.S. for the clearance of snow in the mountainous areas in the coming winter.

12. The Germans took away many of the snow ploughs held by the U.S.V.S., and it is therefore necessary, in order to keep the through routes open, that any snow ploughs there might be, be made available.

13. If the information that there are a large number of surplus army vehicles, (Allied and German) available is correct, and the Military Authorities are favourably disposed towards releasing them to the U.S.V.S. and Genio Civile, will you please let me know if it is possible to get some released to other Regions.

14. In the event of these vehicles being made available it is proposed to put some under control of the Capo Compartimento of each Compartiment, for the maintenance of the roads and reconstruction of bridges, and some to the Genio Civile of each Province to enable them to execute public works reconstruction.
