Reference your letter N° 20125/MFAA of 13th Dec. 1945.

The Regional Engineer Venezia Region has already obtained from the P.W.S.U. Subcommission Headquarters Allied Commission authority to expend L.2.500.000.= on the work of supporting the faulty arches of the Basilica S. Marco Venice, and the work was started about a week ago.

There is therefore no necessity for my approval of Lit.200.000.= to enable the work to be started at once.

The Subdivision of work as recommended in para 3 of your letter has been adopted.

I hope we have started this work in sufficient time to get the faulty arches supported and to prevent any collapse of the building. That would be a disaster.

The Regional Engineer has been most helpful in the matter.

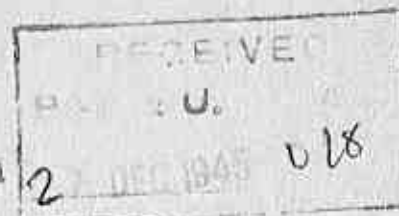
