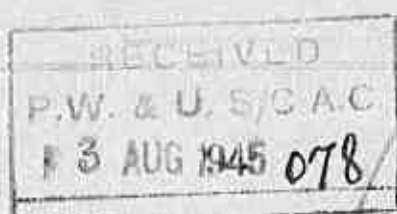

- (a) If of military origin should if possible be replaced by German vehicles which could then be sold as above. The Hahn military vehicles should in any case be referred to M.M.I.A.
- (b) If civilian - can be sold under contract as in (a), but if the original owner lays claim to the vehicle he has a very good right to it.

1. The transportation situation here is such that we are unable to take care of the job that confronts us. The Regional Commissioner has done all he can as we are limited by higher authority to a definite number of vehicles.

2. I have heard that there are some 24 jeeps in Rome belonging to PUAD Sub-Commission and this letter to you is to ask if two of these jeeps could be loaned to this Region PMU at least until we can get organized and operating. The occupation was rapid and under present conditions we do not know what situations exist so that plans are difficult to make. Genio Civile are being organized when we can get to them, but due to shortage of gasoline in the area they are having difficulty in securing field data.

3. Our position of the moment is like this:

Public Works Officer	1 jeep	0
Electricity	0	1
Roads & Bridges	1 jeep	0
Flood Control	1 jeep	0
Housing	0	1
Total	4	2

Two of these cars have been in the shop all week, and as all are in poor condition, the percentage of usable vehicles is liable to continue to force 4 men to depend on 2 vehicles. The tires are bad, especially on the civilian car. To date for this reason little has been accomplished on electricity or housing, and the situation is bad due to lack of information on water and floods.

4. To repeat, this request is only in the hope that at least 2 jeeps can be loaned us from your pool. If you can signal us good news we can pick them up at any time.
