- 2. Since the work referred to in your letter is of civil importance only and if the estimate is excessive it is a concern only of the Italian Government. The entire matter should be referred back to the local Cenio Civile for bandling.

1. Reference your 078/S1/6/PWU dated 6 December 1944.

- 2. Route 120 is not a military highway.
- The 10 Kilometers of roadway for which an estimate was prepared are in a frightful condition.
- a) This bad state of the tract in question was brought about because the whole area around Gerda and the railway station was used as an ammunition deposit and there was an excedingly high concentration traffic for about a year.
- 4. During the writerslast visit to Rome he was informed by Lt. Col. Jenny that the Italian Civil Engineering Authorities would have power to initiate their own civilian schemes without reference to P.W. & Utilities Sub-Commission provided that critical materials were not being used; 176 /PWU dated 16 Nov. 44 para 4 sub paras a)b) refers.
- 5. On point of procedure the writer does not think that he should be called upon to examine these purely civilian schemes. It is up to the Italian Government to find the money and if the figures are considered excessive to refer the matter to the Provveditorato alle OO.PP.
- 6. However if the Sub-Commission wants the writer to carefully to examine this civilian scheme he will do so when the relative documents arrive.
