Subject: Naples-Piedimonte d'Alife.

1. The attached papers are sent you for consideration.
2. This Sub-Commission would be prepared to support electrical operation of the line Anversa-Capua as a temporary measure, the journey Naples-Capua to be made by existing street car services.
3. Reference is, however, made to a prohibition by Allied Authorities for the use of the line other than for the carriage of ballast for road maintenance.
4. It is thought possible that this demand has since lifted, but it is possible you will have some information on the subject.
5. It would not be possible to concede steam operation of the track Capua-Naples, and operation will have to be deferred until electrical repairs can be completed.
